NRC HONORED AS 2012 TOP SUPPORTER OF HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

The 10th annual survey conducted by U.S. Black Engineer & Information Technology magazine lists the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as one of the government agencies considered most supportive of the engineering departments of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU). The full list of these "top supporters" will be published in an upcoming version of the magazine.

The survey is a result of a poll among deans of the accredited HBCU engineering programs and the corporate-academic alliance Advancing Minorities Interest in Engineering.

"The NRC has always been a leader among federal agencies in efforts to strengthen and support HBCUs.
