Voting Systems Technical Oversight Program (VSTOP)

- Started at Ball State in 2008
 - Recommend Systems for State Certification
 - Create Database inventory of voting system
 - Conduct periodic inventory audits
 - Growing responsibilities including monitoring system advisories
- Funded by Indiana Secretary of State's Office
- VSTOP reports to Indiana Election Division (IED) and Indiana Election Commission (IEC)



Clearinghouse Assistance to VSTOP

- Certification
 - EAC Certification not necessary in Indiana but where EAC approved system is introduced, VSTOP utilizes EAC documents including
 - Testing Plans
 - VSTL Reports
 - EAC Certification Documents
 - VSTOP consults EAC testing docs with reference to functionalities pertaining to the Indiana Election Code

ECOs

- Approval draws heavily on definitions and policies outlined in Section 3.5 of EAC Manual.
- EAC Testing Report and EAC Evaluation docs also consulted for EAC approved systems.
