

**SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION FOR LEAVE  
TO FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT**

Pursuant to 16 C.F.R § 1025.13 of the Rules of Practice for Adjudicative Proceedings (“Rules”), Complaint Counsel moves this Court to permit Complaint Counsel to supplement its previously filed Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint in the instant matter. A copy of the previously filed Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint is attached hereto as Attachment 1. Under the Rules, the Presiding Officer “may allow appropriate amendments and supplemental pleadings which do not unduly broaden the issues in the proceedings or cause undue delay.” 16 C.F.R. § 1025.13.

This supplemental motion merely seeks to attach to the Amended Complaint a List and Summary of Documentary Evidence. No changes have been made to the Amended Complaint, and the attached List and Summary of Documentary Evidence is substantively identical to that which was filed with the original Complaint on July 25, 2012. The List and Summary of Documentary Evidence is attached hereto as Attachment 2. Complaint Counsel submits that the filing of this supplemental motion will neither unduly broaden the issues nor cause undue delay, and does not prejudice the Respondent.

Wherefore, Complaint Counsel respectfully requests that the Presiding Officer grant this supplemental motion and allow Complaint Counsel leave to file the List and Summary of Documentary Evidence as an attachment to the Amended Complaint.
