Project Name: Advanced Nuclear Technology Development for Space Propulsion and Power
Amount Requested: \$1,500,000
Recipient: Idaho National Laboratory
Location: Idaho Falls
Public Interest: For space nuclear propulsion system research.
Description: The Idaho National Laboratory's Center for Space Nuclear Research is the lead center for research into space nuclear systems and offers post-graduate and fellowships for students.

Project Name: Anti-Meth Equipment and Operations Project
Amount Requested: \$125,000
Recipient: City of Twin Falls, Idaho
Location: Twin Falls
Public Interest: To support enhanced drug crime prevention activities.
Description: The project will assist the city of Twin Falls Police Department in detecting and combating methamphetamine-related crime through enhanced enforcement and new equipment.
