Turn Up the HEAT!

The Hazard Education and Awareness Tool (HEAT) is an innovative, free tool that brings hazard information to your citizens. The interactive format uses Google Maps to let users enter an address into the search boxes to identify hazard risks near where they live or work.

The tool creates an easy-to-understand risk map that agencies can pair with related educational and awareness information, such as evacuation instructions and sheltering procedures. Getting lifesaving information can be as simple as entering an address!
