Please refer to your application of October 16, 1997, and our interim reply of October 28, 1997, concerning your request for a Coast Guard Permit for the subject project.

We have completed our review of you application. Before we can issue a Public Notice on your proposal, it will be necessary to revise the permit drawings as shown in green on the enclosed Sheets 2 and 3 of 4.

In addition to the revised drawings we need the following to further process your application:

- a. A copy of a Water Quality Certificate or waiver, or a copy of your application for same.
- b. An estimate cost of similar low level bridge providing only sufficient clearance for passage of flood waters and drift. If estimate is not made, state why.
- c. A list of the Wild, Scenic, and Recreational Rivers in Tennessee.

Upon receipt of the revised drawings and additional materials or information, we will issue a Public Notice providing interested parties about thirty days to comment on the project. Any objections or adverse comments received in response to the Public Notice will be forwarded to you for your consideration and coordination.

After the Public Notice expires, and any objections are resolved, your application will be forwarded to the Commandant, U.S. Coast Guard, Washington, DC, for final review and action.
