TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY (TVA) – MINOR PERMIT MODIFICATION – ASH
LANDFILL – KINGSTON FOSSIL PLANT

As we discussed with you in a meeting on March 8, 2006, TVA requests a minor permit modification for the existing permitted landfill at our Kingston Fossil Plant. This modification will change the route of the discharge from the existing dredge cells into the ash pond. As we discussed, TVA would like to make these modifications this summer.
