Disclaimer and Waiver of Liability

This liability statement allows entry upon lands owned by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for hunting. Permittee is not allowed to hunt until this statement is signed. The Corps of Engineers does not know the proficiency of the other participating hunters, and the Corps specifically does not make any warranty or representation of any type, kind or character, whatsoever, as to existing conditions upon said lands for hunting purposes. Any person entering upon such lands enters at his or her own risk, impliedly accepts such lands in the existing conditions and recognizes that all hunting is potentially dangerous because of the use of firearms/bows by hunters of varying degrees of proficiency, and in consideration of being permitted to participate in this public hunting program, I as parent or guardian of any accompanying minor, unconditionally release and hold harmless the Corps of Engineers against and for all liability, cost, expenses, claims and damages for which the Corps might otherwise become liable by reason of any accidents, or injuries to or death of any persons, or damage to property or both, in any manner arising or resulting from, caused by, connected with or related to the presence of any such person upon such lands and premises, regardless of how, where, or when such injury, death or damage occurs even if caused by the negligence of the Corps of Engineers, its agents, servants, or employees, or due to conditions or operation on or defects in the premises. I, the permittee, have read this release and understand all its terms. I execute it voluntarily with full knowledge of its significance.

PROCTOR LAKE HUNTING PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Applicant must complete the Hunting Permit Application.
- 2. A Texas Hunting License is required.
- 3. A Hunter Safety Education Course Certificate is required if you were born after September 2, 1971. (See the Fort Worth District Public Hunting Guide or the TPWD Outdoor Annual for further information).
- 4. A state issued driver's license or identification card is required.
- 5. Applicant must be 17 years of age.
- Types of Hunting Permits
 a. Applicant may apply for all hunting types.
 - b. <u>Ducks</u> Allowed by drawing only. Includes all wild species of ducks, and any legal birds allowed during the early season.. (See TPWD Outdoor Annual for complete description of legal waterfowl) Duck hunting is allowed in the main lake and does not require a permit. See below for drawing information.
 - c. <u>Dove</u> Allowed by permit only. Includes mourning doves, white-winged doves, white-tipped (white-fronted) doves. (See TPWD Outdoor Annual for complete description of legal dove) See below for drawing information.
 - d. <u>Small Game</u> Allowed to be taken at Proctor Lake are all legal small game and non-game animals.
 - e. <u>Feral Hog</u> Allowed by drawing only. Considered an exotic animal in Texas and exotic rules and regulations apply. See below for drawing information.
- 7. A permit for Waterfowl, Dove and Feral Hogs are drawing hunts only. A random drawing will be conducted and all persons selected will be notified by mail. Application deadlines and season are listed below.
- 8. Applicant must provide proof of all required documents prior to hunting permit being issued.
- 9. The Disclaimer and Waiver of Liability must be signed and attached with the application.
- 10. Hunting is only allowed by permit in the Upper Leon River and Sabanna River Wildlife Management Areas. No permit required for hunting ducks on main lake.
- 11. All State and Federal Hunting Rules and Regulations, and Title 36 CFR Rules and Regulations will be strictly

enforced. Failure to follow the established rules and regulations will lead to any and all hunting permits to be revoked.

PROCTOR LAKE DRAWING DEADLINES AND SEASONS

DUCKS (Season: State Waterfowl Season, But Ending December 31, 2012)

Waterfowl hunting in the Upper Leon River and Sabanna River Wildlife Management Areas are allowed by drawing only. Permits are not required for waterfowl hunting on the main lake. All waterfowl permit applications are due 1 week prior to the Proctor Lake Waterfowl Season.

DOVE (Season: State Dove Season, But Ending December 31, 2012)

Dove hunting is allowed by drawing only. Dove hunting is only allowed in the Upper Leon River and Sabanna River Wildlife Management Areas. All dove permit applications are due 1 week prior to the Proctor Lake Dove Season.

<u>SMALL GAME</u> (Season: Year Round Except During Drawn Feral Hog Hunts)

Small game hunting is allowed throughout the year except during the designated feral hog hunting dates. There is not a drawing for a small game permit. Hunters can apply for a small game permit at any time.

FERAL HOG (Season: January 7, 2013 – March 31, 2013)

Feral hog hunting is allowed by drawing only. Feral hog hunting is only allowed in the Upper Leon River and Sabanna River Wildlife Management Areas. All permit applications must be received 2 weeks prior to the opening of the Proctor Lake Feral Hog Season.
