E-Verify began verifying Florida driver's licenses and state identification cards in December 2012. Effective January 17, E-Verify also verifies Mississippi (MS) state identification cards. 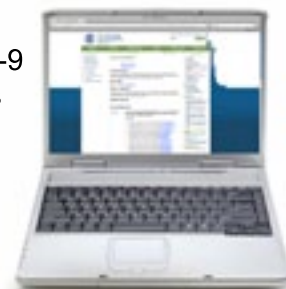
