## **ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS**

---

### **INVESTMENT ADVISER CENSURED, ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST AND FINED FOR FAILING TO MAKE TIMELY YEAR 2000-RELATED DISCLOSURE**

The Commission announced today that it entered an Order Making Findings, Issuing Cease and Desist Order and Imposing Civil Penalty as to Robert C Sears (Order). The Commission accepted Sears' Offer of Settlement, in which he agreed to the following relief: a censure, an order that he cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of the ADV-Y2K provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, Section 204 and Rule 204-5. Additionally, Sears was ordered to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty.

The Order finds that Sears was required to and failed to file Part I of Form ADV-Y2K by June 7, 1999. Form ADV-Y2K was designed to enable the Commission to evaluate the preparedness of investment advisers for the Year 2000 (Rel IA-1858, File No 3-9985).

### **RECEIVER APPOINTED IN MOBLEY CASE**

The United States District Court has appointed Otto G Obermaier, a partner at the law firm of Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP in New York City, as the receiver for David M Mobley, Sr., Maricopa Investment Fund, Ltd., and the other defendants and relief defendants.

Under the Court's order, Mr Obermaier is empowered to take possession of all of the defendants' and relief defendants' assets and to search for any hidden or undisclosed assets. Mr Obermaier is required to prepare a report by May 31, 2000, setting forth, among other

things, the defendants' and relief defendants' assets and liabilities, all funds and other assets received by the defendants and relief defendants since September 1, 1992, and all funds and other assets disbursed by the defendants and relief defendants since September 1, 1992

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### SCUDDER GLOBAL FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Scudder Global Fund, et al. under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions. The order permits certain registered management investment companies and certain entities that are excluded from the definition of investment company by Section 3(c)(1), 3(c)(7) or 3(c)(11) of the Act to invest uninvested cash in (a) affiliated money market funds and/or short-term bond funds or (b) one or more affiliated entities that operate as cash management investment vehicles and that are excluded from the definition of investment company by Section 3(c)(1) or 3(c)(7) of the Act. ### SELIGMAN PORTFOLIOS, INC. AND J. & W. SELIGMAN & CO. INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Seligman Portfolios, Inc. (Seligman Portfolios) and J. & W. Seligman & Co. Inc. (Seligman) (together, Applicants). Applicants seek an order to permit shares of Seligman Portfolios and shares of any other open-end investment company that is designed to fund insurance products and for which Seligman or any of its affiliates may serve now or in the future, as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter, or sponsor to be offered to, sold to and held by (1) variable annuity and variable life insurance separated accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies, and (2) qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. ### FIRST AMERICAN INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by First American Investment Funds, Inc., et al. for exemptions from Sections 10(f) and 17(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act

The order permits certain registered management investment companies to purchase certain securities from an affiliated underwriter and through group orders placed with an underwriting syndicate that includes the affiliated underwriter (Rel IC-24324 – March 1)

## **THE VICTORY PORTFOLIOS, ET AL.**

An order has been issued on an application filed by The Victory Portfolios, et al. under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (Act) for an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act. The order amends a prior order that permits non-money market series of a registered open-end management investment company to purchase shares of one or more of the money market series of such registered investment company by adding a registered open-end management investment company and an investment adviser as applicants. ## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

### **NORTHEAST UTILITIES**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 23 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, in connection with the proposed merger of NU and Consolidated Edison, Inc (CEI), a New York electric and gas public utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act under Rule 2, for NU to amend its trust agreement. The amendments to the trust agreement will allow for the merger and allow the merger agreement to fix the number of NU trustees. An order has been issued authorizing NU to solicit proxies from its common shareholders to obtain required approval of the merger and to solicit proxies to amend the trust agreement (Rel 35-27144)

### **APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE**

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-97-89) which will permit NASD members and associated persons to include bond mutual fund volatility ratings in supplemental sales literature for an 18 month trial period. Publication in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 6 (Rel 34-42476)

## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-00-07) regarding the extension of its after-hours trading pilot has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
