COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ESTEE LEVINE NAMED COUNSELOR TO CHAIRMAN ARTHUR LEVITT

On March 9, Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Arthur Levitt named Estee S. Levine Counsel to the Chairman. Ms. Levine succeeds Tracey E. Aronson, who was named Director of the Office of Congressional and Intergovernmental Affairs. Ms. Levine commences her new duties immediately. Ms. Levine will be focusing on investment management and international issues.

Chairman Levitt said, "I am pleased to welcome Estee to my staff. During these interesting and dynamic times Estee's counsel on a variety of issues will be important."

Ms. Levine joined the SEC's Office of General Counsel in 1997. Most recently, Ms. Levine served as Senior Special Counsel in that office, specializing in issues involving corporation finance, accounting, and international affairs. Prior to joining the Commission, Ms. Levine practiced corporate and securities law at the law firm of Baker & Botts, LLP in Washington, DC.

Ms. Levine, 33, earned both her J.D. and B.A. degrees from Duke University. (Press Rel. 2000-27)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INVESTMENT ADVISER CENSURED, ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST AND FINED FOR FAILING TO MAKE TIMELY YEAR 2000-RELATED DISCLOSURE

The Securities and Exchange Commission announced today that it entered an Order Making Findings, Issuing Cease-and-Desist Order and Imposing Civil Penalty against WWW Advisors, Inc. (WWW). The Commission accepted WWW's Offer of Settlement, in which it agreed to a censure and an order that it cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of the ADV-Y2K provisions of the Investment Advisers Act, Section 204 and Rule 204-5. Additionally, WWW was ordered to pay a \$5,000 civil

penalty. WWW consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

The Order finds that WWW was required to and failed to file Parts I and II of Form ADV-Y2K by December 7, 1998. Form ADV-Y2K was designed to enable the Commission to evaluate the preparedness of investment advisers for the Year 2000. (IAA-1860; File No. 3-9888)

COURT GRANTS SUMMARY JUDGMENT AGAINST TWO ATTORNEYS IN ACTION INVOLVING FORGED AND FICTITIOUS SECURITIES

On February 24, 2000, the Honorable John G. Koeltl of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York granted the Commission's motion for summary judgment against Daniel T. Todt and Rebecca L. Todt in an action involving the offer and attempt to sell forged and fictitious securities. The Court entered final judgments against Daniel and Rebecca Todt on February 28, 2000, enjoining them from their violative conduct and ordering them to pay civil penalties of \$200,000 and \$100,000, respectively. On March 7, 2000, the Court denied a motion by the Todts to alter or amend the final judgments.

The Court found in its February 24 Opinion and Order that the Todts, husband and wife, attempted to obtain money on four occasions by using a fraudulent bank certificate purportedly issued by the "Mitsubishi B.J. Bank," with a face value equivalent to nearly six billion dollars. The Court found that these attempts to obtain money using the Mitsubishi certificate violated the antifraud provisions of both the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 despite the fact that the attempts were unsuccessful.

The Court found that the Todts made repeated attempts to obtain funds using the Mitsubishi certificate even though they both knew it was a forgery, and "persisted in their efforts to dispose of the Certificate for value even after entry of a preliminary injunction against them." The Court found "ample evidence of motive and opportunity to defraud" and "a strong basis for concluding that the Todts, unless enjoined from doing so, will again violate federal securities laws."

The Todts were the only remaining defendants in this matter. Six defendants previously consented to injunctive relief and, in two instances, civil penalties. One defendant had a default judgment entered against him.
