ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION IMPOSED AGAINST ASIF AMEEN

On October 17, the Commission entered an Administrative Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Asif Ameen (Ameen) of Wichita, Kansas. The Order makes findings that from approximately 1992 through mid 1997, Ameen, a Bangladesh native who was then employed as a registered representative at Primeline Securities Corp., a Wichita, Kansas broker-dealer, operated an investment program in which he paid investors their promised returns with funds that he obtained from subsequent investors. The Order also finds that Ameen converted to his own use funds from the securities accounts of many of his Primeline customers. The Order further finds that Ameen was convicted on April 16, 1998 of four state counts of felony theft and one state count of securities fraud related to his thefts, and that on December 14, 1998 he pleaded no contest to, and was judged guilty on five additional felony theft and securities fraud charges related to his actions. The Order, to which Ameen consented, bars him from association with any broker or dealer. (Rel. 34-43449; File No. 3-9906)

ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST BRUCE BERTSCH

On October 17, the Commission entered an Administrative Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Bruce W. Bertsch (Bertsch) of Valley Center, Kansas. The Order makes findings that from approximately 1994 through mid 1997, Bertsch, while employed at Primeline Securities Corp., a registered broker-dealer based in Wichita, Kansas, was responsible for supervising Asif Ameen (Ameen), a registered representative at that firm who stole funds from his clients. The Order finds that Bertsch failed to reasonably supervise Ameen with a view to preventing Ameen's violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with his thefts. The Order, to which Bertsch consented, suspends Bertsch from association with any broker or dealer for three months, bars him from association in a supervisory or proprietary capacity with any broker or dealer with a right to reapply for such association after two years, and imposes a civil money penalty of \$10,000. JEROME BECHSTEIN ENJOINED AND FINED FOR FRAUD IN TOWNE BANCORP'S OFFERING

On October 4, an injunctive Order was entered in a case filed by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission against Jerome C. Bechstein, a resident of Bowling Green, Ohio, for fraud in the sale of Towne Bancorp, Inc. stock. Under the Order, Bechstein, a former president and director of Towne Bancorp, is enjoined from violating antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, and must pay a civil penalty of \$25,000. Bechstein consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint.

The complaint alleges that Towne Bancorp's registered "mini-max" offering required the company to raise \$4 million by June 30, 1994, subject to an extension, or else the offering would terminate and all funds paid by subscribers would be returned with interest. Towne Bancorp raised only \$2.5 million by June 30, 1994 and it did not extend the offering. However, Bechstein failed to return funds to investors as promised and improperly continued to sell Towne Bancorp stock subscriptions through November 1995. During that time, Bechstein failed to disclose to investors that the offering was not extended past June 30, 1994; that investors' funds were not returned; and that Towne Bancorp, thus, had a significant outstanding liability. Further, Towne Bancorp, through Bechstein, did not properly report the outstanding liability with the Commission. The complaint specifically alleges that Bechstein violated Sections 5(b), 10(a)(3) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act), and Rules 10b-5 and 10b-9 promulgated thereunder, and from aiding and abetting an issuer's violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 promulgated thereunder. CORRECTION

A News Digest item that was published on August 17, 2000, under the heading "FORMER OFFICERS OF ALIAS RESEARCH, INC. ENJOINED; COMMISSION BARS WILLIAM McCLINTOCK" contained an error.

The first two sentences of the third paragraph of the item should have read: "On July 24, 2000, the court permanently enjoined McClintock from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b) and 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 13b2-1 and 13b2-2 thereunder. The final judgment also prohibits McClintock for a period of five years from acting as an officer or director of a public company."

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EATON VANCE MANAGEMENT, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Eaton Vance Management, et al. exempting applicants from Sections 18(c) and 18(i) of the Investment Company Act, and pursuant to Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act. The order permits certain registered closed-end management investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares, and would amend a prior order that permits the imposition of asset-based distribution fees. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

IES UTILITIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 7, 2000, to request a hearing on a proposal by IES Utilities, Inc., a wholly owned public utility subsidiary of Alliant Energy Corporation, a registered holding company, to extend the time in which it may issue its notes and debentures in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$200 million and provide related collateral, from December 31, 2000 through June 30, 2004. (Rel. 35-27251)

INTERSTATE POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 7, 2000, to request a hearing on a proposal by Interstate Power Company, a wholly owned public utility subsidiary of Alliant Energy Corporation, a registered holding company, to extend the time in which it may issue its first mortgage bonds and debentures and issue notes in connection with the sale of tax-exempt bonds in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$80 million, from December 31, 2000 through June 30, 2004. ALABAMA POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 7, 2000, to request a hearing on a proposal by Alabama Power Company, Georgia Power Company, Gulf Power Company and Mississippi Power Company, each an electric public utility subsidiary company of the Southern Company, a registered holding company, to solicit proxies from their common and preferred shareholders and to amend their articles of incorporation. The Commission has issued an order authorizing the proposed solicitation of proxies, effective immediately, under Rule 62(d). (Rel. 35-27252)

WGL HOLDINGS, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by WGL Holdings (WGL), currently a wholly owned subsidiary of Washington Gas Light Company (Washington Gas), a gas utility company not currently subject to the Act, and Washington Gas' nonutility

subsidiary companies, Hampshire Gas Company, Crab Run Gas Company, Brandywood Estates, Inc., Washington Gas Resources Corp. and Primary Investors, LLC have filed an application-declaration requesting authorization through March 31, 2004 for a series of financings and activities including hedging transactions, a money pool agreement, changes in capital stock of subsidiaries, payment of dividends out of capital or unearned surplus, energy consumer financing activities, services agreements, creation of certain subsidiary companies and issuance of common stock, preferred stock, debentures and guarantees. Washington Gas intends to reorganize with WGL becoming a holding company over Washington Gas. WGL will register under the Act. (Rel. 35-27253)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 10, 2000, to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Mobile Energy Services Holdings, Inc. and Mobile Energy Services Company, L.L.C. requesting that the SEC issue (1) an order under Section 11(f) of the Act approving the amended Joint Plan of Reorganization and certain related transactions and (2) a report on the amended Joint Plan of Reorganization under Section 11(g) that may accompany a solicitation of creditors and any other interest holders for approval of the amended Joint Plan of Reorganization in the bankruptcy proceedings. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-00-83) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to distribute Quality of Execution Reports to specialists and order flow providers, has become immediately effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-43436)

A proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-00-40) submitted by the New York Stock Exchange regarding Section 804 of the NYSE Listed Company Manual has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-43442)

A proposed rule change (SR-CHX-00-32) filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange relating to partial automatic executions of Nasdaq/NM securities (SR-CHX-00-32) has become immediately effective and operative under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-43444)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-00-55) relating to the delivery requirement of a margin disclosure statement to non-institutional customers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-43441)

A proposed rule change has been filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-00-05) to allow NSCC to modify its rules to permit additional types of investment products to be processed through NSCC's Mutual Fund Services. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 23. (Rel. 34-43447)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-00-35) relating to manual handling of RAES orders in certain limited situations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 23. (Rel. 34-43448)
