ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC IMPOSES PENNY STOCK BAR AGAINST PROMOTER STANLEY SCHULMAN

On December 1, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an administrative Order that bars Stanley Schulman of Devore, California, from participating in any offering or distribution of penny stock. This Order is related to the settlement announced recently in connection with the Commission's lawsuit against Schulman in SEC v. Nemdaco Inc., Stanley Schulman, Jeffrev R. Bender and Gary J. Larkin, U.S.D.C. for the Central District of California, Eastern Division, Civil Action No. EDCV-00861 RT(SGLx). In that case, the Court permanently enjoined Schulman from violation of the antifraud, registration and position reporting provisions of the securities laws. The Court also barred Schulman from acting as an officer or director of any public company.

The Commission's lawsuit alleged that Schulman took secret control of a penny stock issuer -Nemdaco, Inc. - and proceeded to orchestrate a fraudulent manipulation and unregistered distribution of Nemdaco's stock to the investing public. LESLIE E ROSSELLO, FORMER DEAN WITTER REYNOLDS INC. REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE, ENGAGED IN VIOLATIVE MUTUAL FUND SWITCHING

On December 1, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Public Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b), 19(h) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings, Imposing Remedial Sanctions and Monetary Penalties, and Imposing Cease-and-Desist Order against Leslie E. Rossello.

The Commission found that on forty-eight different occasions, from March 1994 through November 1996, Rossello engaged in violative mutual fund switching to the detriment of her customers. Rossello induced the switches for her benefit rather than that of her customers. As a result of these transactions, Rossello increased her commissions while her customers incurred approximately \$157,000 in sales charges. The Commission also found that in connection with the violative mutual fund switches, Rossello misrepresented and omitted to inform those customers of material facts, including, but

not limited to the payment of contingent deferred sales charges and the amount of those sales charges, and the option of exchanging their fund shares for another mutual fund in the same family of funds at little or no cost. Furthermore, the Commission found that Rossello failed to disclose the unsuitable nature of the frequency of these switches to her customers notwithstanding that she knew that mutual funds are generally long-term investments and not suitable for short-term trading.

The Commission found that Rossello's mutual fund switches, misrepresentations and omissions, and unsuitable recommendations violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Order suspends Rossello from association with any broker-dealer for a period of twelve months, orders her to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation and any future violation of the antifraud provisions, and orders her to pay a civil money penalty of \$10,000. SEC SUSPENDS AND FINES STOCK BROKER STEVEN SCOTT FOR ROLE IN "HYPER AND DUMP" OF NEMDACO STOCK

On December 1, the Commission instituted settled administrative proceedings against Steven E. Scott, a stockbroker now living in Stoughton, Massachusetts, for his role in the unregistered distribution of the stock of Nemdaco, Inc. to the public. The Commission's Order fines Scott \$10,000 and suspends him from association with any broker or dealer for six months. This matter is related to the recently announced filing of a settled injunctive action in the U.S. District Court of the Central District of California against Nemdaco, Inc., stock promoter Stanley Schulman, Jeffrey R. Bender and Gary J. Larkin for the "hype and dump" of the stock of Nemdaco, a shell corporation that was once listed on the NASDAQ Bulletin Board.

The Commission's complaint alleges that Schulman took secret control of Nemdaco and, with the assistance of Bender and Larkin, orchestrated a "hype and dump" of Nemdaco stock by issuing numerous false and misleading press releases. After the market price for Nemdaco stock had risen because of the false publicity, Schulman sold millions of worthless Nemdaco shares through nominee brokerage accounts with the help of his broker, Steven Scott. Scott thereby assisted with an unregistered distribution of Nemdaco stock by executing the stock sales.

Without admitting or denying the findings, Scott consented to the entry of a Commission Order finding that he caused violations of Section 5 of the Securities Act of 1933, ordering him to cease and desist from causing such violations, suspending him from association with any broker or dealer for a period of six months, and ordering him to pay a civil penalty of \$ 10,000. THE ADVANTUS SERIES FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Advantus Series Fund, Inc. (Advantus Fund) and Advantus Capital Management, Inc. (Advantus Capital), the investment adviser of Advantus Fund (collectively, the Applicants). SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-00-54) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange relating to membership fees, has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43639)

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-00-19) under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change will implement a new tax service called DALI, which is a communications hub to be used by U.S. payors such as banks, broker-dealers and foreign customers in order to exchange data to determine the proper withholding amount and to report U.S. withholding tax on payments such as dividends and interest made to a foreign payee.
