### DISGORGEMENT JUDGMENTS ENTERED AGAINST FORMER COMPARATOR OFFICERS ROGERS AND ARMIJO; DEFAULT JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST FORMER COMPARATOR OFFICER HITT

The Commission announced today that on August 14 the Honorable Lourdes G. Baird, United States District Judge, entered Supplemental Judgments against defendants Robert Reed Rogers and Gregory Armijo. Rogers was formerly the chairman, chief executive officer and treasurer of Comparator Systems Corporation (Comparator); Armijo was formerly Comparator's vice president for operations, corporate secretary and a member of Comparator's board of directors. The Supplemental Judgment against defendant Rogers orders him to pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest in the total amount of \$297,496.67. Rogers also was ordered to disgorge 30,536,575 shares of Comparator stock and to disavow all debts owed to him by Comparator and incurred during the period covered by the Commission's complaint. The Supplemental Judgment against defendant Armijo orders him to pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest totalling \$129,429.06. Armijo also was ordered to disgorge 3,579,816 shares of Comparator stock and to disavow all debts owed to him by Comparator and incurred during the period covered by the Commission's complaint. The injunctive relief and the officer and director bars ordered against defendants Rogers and Armijo on September 18, 1996 remain in full force and effect; the Commission withdrew its claim for civil money penalties against those defendants.

The Commission also announced today that on May 18, 1998, the Court entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief by Default Against Defendant Scott Hitt. Hitt was formerly Comparator's executive vice president and a member of Comparator's board of directors. That Judgment permanently restrains and enjoins defendant Hitt from violating the anti-fraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of the securities laws, specifically Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b) (2) (A) - (B), and 13(b) (5) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 13a-1, 13a-13, 13b2-1, and 12b-20 thereunder. The

judgment also permanently bars Hitt from serving in the future as an officer or director of any public corporation; orders him to disgorge \$516,614.31 along with prejudgment interest of \$87,635.35 thereon; orders him to pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$516,614.31; and continues the freezes on Hitt's assets. **TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION OBTAINED AGAINST INTERNET CASINO SPORTS GAMING, LLC AND ITS PRINCIPALS FOR SECURITIES REGISTRATION, ANTIFRAUD AND BROKER-DEALER REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS**

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint under seal on August 10 in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California against Internet Casino Sports Gaming, LLC (Internet Casino); Internet Casino Sports Gaming, Inc.; Robert Matias a/k/a Robert DuVall and Alan Lenchner a/k/a Alan Lane. The Commission obtained a temporary restraining order on August 12 and preliminary injunction on August 17 freezing the assets of the defendants and enjoining the defendants from future violations of the securities registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, consented to the entry of the preliminary injunction and asset freeze. The complaint seeks a permanent injunction, disgorgement of ill-gotten gains and the imposition of civil penalties against the defendants.

The complaint alleges that the defendants raised approximately \$2 million from the offer and sale of limited liability units of Internet Casino to about 152 investors nationwide. The defendants represented that investor funds would be used to develop and operate a virtual casino on-line website. However, the complaint alleges that the defendants misused investors' funds by spending only approximately 10% of investor funds on the development and licensing of the website while spending almost all of the remainder of the funds on undisclosed and undetermined expenses, including undisclosed sales commissions from 35-40% to sales agents and the defendants, salaries and other payments to the defendants and their family members, undisclosed automobile allowances for the defendants and operating costs of the boiler room soliciting investors. The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-98-19) to amend Amex Rule 950, "Rules of General Applicability," to allow members to solicit customers to participate in certain options transactions and to codify the Amex's policy prohibiting the use of non-public information regarding the terms and conditions of solicited orders, orders being facilitated, or orders being crossed to buy or sell the underlying security or related securities.
