ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST KENTON CAPITAL, LTD., DONALD WALLACE, JEFFREY CARTER, DELTAUR PARTNERS, HARRY WATSON, TRACY FRENCH, TERRENCE PLACK, ATLANTIC PACIFIC GUARANTEE CORPORATION AND CHARLES SMITH

The Commission announced that on June 23 Judge Gladys Kessler of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia entered Preliminary Injunctions against defendants Kenton Capital, Ltd., Donald C. Wallace, Jeffrey E. Carter, Deltaur Partners, Harry Watson, Tracy L. French and Terrence Plack in the above-referenced case, which involves the fraudulent sale of unregistered securities. The defendants, without admitting or denying any of the allegations in the Commission's Complaint, consented to the entry of the Preliminary Injunctions, which continue, with certain modifications, provisions of emergency relief ordered by the Court on May 5, 1995, including an asset freeze and other provisions of the Temporary Restraining Order. The defendants are restrained from violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Rule 203(a) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Relief Defendants Charles E. Smith and Atlantic Pacific Guarantee Corporation also consented to the entry of an order by the Court freezing their assets and preserving investor funds. Under the terms of the Preliminary Injunctions, defendants have been ordered to return to the United States over one million dollars received from U.S. investors that are now in accounts in the Cayman Islands. These funds are to be paid into the registry of the U.S. District Court for the purpose of disgorging those funds to investors.

The Commission's complaint, filed on May 3, 1995, alleges that defendants are involved in a scheme in which they told investors that they could use \$2,000,000 in pooled investor funds to borrow \$100,000,000 of U.S. Treasury securities, pledge the rented securities to a foreign bank to borrow \$90,000,000 in cash, and then use the loan

proceeds to fund trading in so-called "bank instruments." Defendants also told investors that the trading would occur on an international, off-balance sheet market for "bank instruments," which, according to the Commission and recent court decisions, does not exist. The Complaint further alleges that defendants have promised investors under some schemes weekly profits of from 110% to over 3,000%, and under other schemes, annual returns ranging from 34,200% to over 1,200,000%, with little or no risk. FINAL JUDGMENTS AGAINST JERRY FRASCHILLA AND DARLENE GILLESPIE

On June 14, the United States District Court for the Central District of California entered final judgments against Jerry J. Fraschilla and Darlene Gillespie. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, Fraschilla and Gillespie consented to permanent injunctions prohibiting violations of the antifraud provisions and the margin requirements of the federal securities laws, Section 10(b) and 7(f) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Rule 10b-5 thereunder and Section 3(b) of Regulation X promulgated by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. Fraschilla and Gillespie were also ordered to pay disgorgement of \$76,002.52 and \$6,243.09, respectively, and to pay civil penalties of the same amounts.

The Commission's complaint alleged that from approximately August 1992 through May 1993 the defendants systematically placed purchase orders on margin for the common stock of Unique Mobility Corporation, a stock listed for trading on the American Stock Exchange, without the intention or the means to pay for the purchases. The complaint further alleged that the defendants misstated their financial resources, caused several brokerage firms to suffer losses, and caused all the brokerage firms at which they placed the orders to unknowingly assume the risk of losses. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KANSAS CITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Kansas City Life Insurance Company, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order would permit applicants to deduct a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of certain separate accounts established by applicants to support certain variable annuity accounts. ANCHOR NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Anchor National Life Insurance Company (Anchor National), Variable Annuity Account Four (Variable Account), and SunAmerica Capital Services, Inc. (collectively, Applicants). Applicants seek an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk and distribution expense risk charges from the assets of the Variable Account, and of any other separate account established in the future by Anchor National, in connection with the issuance and sale of certain flexible payment deferred annuity contracts.
