ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

TRADING SUSPENSION IN THE SECURITIES OF GARCIS U.S.A., INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Garcis U.S.A., Inc., for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. on October 13, 1995, and terminating at 11:59 P.M. on October 26, 1995. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Garcia in view of questions that have been raised about the accuracy and adequacy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the identity of the persons in control of the operations and management of the company, the amount of sales and customer orders received by Garcis, and contracts entered into by Garcis. COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST PERSONAL WEALTH SYSTEMS, INC. AND ITS PRESIDENT, GARY HAISER

The Commission announced that on May 30 a complaint was filed by the Commission seeking permanent injunctive relief, civil penalties, an accounting and disgorgement against Personal Wealth Systems, Inc. (PWS), a privately-held Florida corporation based in Jacksonville, Florida and Gary M. Haiser (Haiser), its president, also of Jacksonville, Florida.

The complaint seeks to enjoin PWS and Haiser from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleges that from at least June 1986 through at least June 1994, PWS and Haiser operated a multilevel marketing pyramid scheme by offering and selling memberships in the pyramid to the public in an unregistered distribution. The complaint also alleges that PWS and Haiser made fraudulent misrepresentations and omissions of material facts concerning the potential return associated with the purchase of a membership, the risk of market saturation, and the prior financial performance of PWS. The complaint alleges that PWS raised approximately \$7.7 million, of which approximately \$6 million was generated from membership sales. [SEC v. Personal Wealth Systems, Inc. and Gary M. FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISGORGEMENT ENTERED AGAINST UNITED COMMUNICATIONS, LTD., GREG PARKER AND ROBERT PALMAREZ

On October 10, the Honorable James Robertson, United States District Judge for the District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment of Disgorgement against defendants United Communications, Ltd. (UCL), Greg E. Parker and Robert Palmarez. The Final Judgment orders these defendants collectively to disgorge the sum of \$12,334,040 (\$3,997,040 by the individuals and \$8,337,000 by UCL), to be funded through the liquidation of interests in wireless cable television licenses and related assets held by them. Defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, consented to entry of the Order.

The Commission's complaint, filed February 27, 1995, alleged that these and other defendants offered and sold unregistered securities of limited liability companies purportedly organized to develop wireless cable television systems, through unregistered high pressure telemarketing sales organizations, and misrepresented and omitted material facts concerning the risks and rewards of the ventures. The funds disgorged by UCL, Parker and Palmarez will be paid to the UCL Disgorgement Fund established February 27, 1995 pursuant to the Final Judgment entered against relief defendant TechniVision, Inc., and will be held with funds disgorged by other defendants for distribution to investors at the close of the case. The case is continuing against the remaining defendants. [SEC v. United Communications, Ltd., Civil Action No. 95-0400, JR, D.D.C.] (LR-14687)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FRANKLIN LIFE VARIABLE ANNUITY FUND A, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Franklin Life Variable Annuity Fund A (Fund A), Franklin Life Variable Annuity Fund B (Fund B), Franklin Life Money Market Variable Annuity Fund C (Fund C, collectively, with Fund A and Fund B, Funds), and The Franklin Life Insurance Company (The Franklin). The application requests an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Act to permit The Franklin to have served as investment advisor, without formal approval by the contract owners of the Funds, pursuant to interim investment management agreements (Interim Agreements). The conditional order would cover the period from January 31, 1995 until April 17, 1995 (Interim Period) and would permit The Franklin to receive from the Funds fees earned under the Interim Agreements. PAINWEBBER PREMIER INTERMEDIATE TAX-FREE INCOME FUND INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by PaineWebber Premier Intermediate Tax-Free Income Fund Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-21414 - October 11)

ANTHEM FUNDS TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Anthem Funds Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-21415 - October 11)

UNITED FINANCIAL GROUP, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by United Financial Group, Inc. for an order under Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from all provisions of the Act until December 30, 1996. The requested exemption would extend an exemption originally granted until December 30, 1990 and extended by five subsequent orders until December 30, 1995. (Rel. IC-21416 - October 12)

SAFECO LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting SAFECO Life Insurance Company (SAFECO), First SAFECO National Life Insurance Company of New York (First SAFECO), SAFECO Separate Account C (Account C), SAFECO Resource Variable Account B (Resource Account), SAFECO Securities, Inc., and PNMR Securities, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order provides exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of Account C, the Resource Account, or any separate account established in the future by SAFECO or First SAFECO in connection with certain variable annuity contracts (Contracts). The exemptions also would apply to any other registered broker-dealer, which is or will be controlling, controlled by, or under common control with SAFECO, and which may serve in the future as principal underwriter for variable annuity contracts that are similar in all material respects to the Contracts and that are offered in the future by SAFECO or First SAFECO. (Rel. IC-21417 - October 12)

INTEGRITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Integrity Life Insurance Company (Integrity), Separate Account I of Integrity Life Insurance Company (Account I), Separate Account II of Integrity Life Insurance Company (Account II, Account I together with Account II, Separate Accounts), and Integrity Financial Services, Inc. (Services) from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Separate Accounts or other Separate Accounts established by Integrity to support certain flexible premium variable annuity policies (Contracts) as well as other variable annuity contracts that are substantially similar in all material respects to the Contracts (Future Contracts). In addition, Services may replace Integrity as principal underwriter for the Contracts. The order extends to Services and any other broker-dealer that may in the future serve a principal underwriter for the Contracts or Future Contracts, the same exemptions previously granted to Integrity. (Rel. IC-21418 -October 12)

INVESTOR AB

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Investor AB for an order under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act declaring it to be primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding, or trading in securities. Investor AB is a Swedish diversified industrial holding company. (Rel. IC-21419; International Series Rel. 867 - October 12)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-95-17) filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange which amends PSE Rule 6.8, "Position Limits," and 6.9, "Exercise Limits," to require PSE members who trade non-PSE-listed option contracts and who are not members of the exchange where the options are traded to comply with the option position and exercise limits set by the exchange where the transactions are effected. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 6. (Rel. 34-36350)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-95-46) to extend for two years, until October 11, 1997, the pilot operation of the Nasdaq International Service and the effectiveness of the International Rules governing broker-dealers' access to and use of the Service. The proposed rule change does not entail any modification of the International Rules. (Rel. 34-36359)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted temporary approval through September 30, 1996 to a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-95-12) that modifies the amount of a member's required clearing fund deposit that may be collateralized by letters of credit. (Rel. 34-36360)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission received a proposal (SR-CBOE-95-57) from the Chicago Board Options Exchange to modify its policy concerning the date of the annual rebalancing of the Japanese Export Stock Index (Index) such that the Index will be rebalanced as of the last trading day of March each year. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-36361)
