INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HIGH ROLLERS GAMING SECTOR FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that High Rollers Gaming Sector Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20022 - January 19)

SUNAMERICA MULTI-ASSET PORTFOLIOS, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that SunAmerica Multi-Asset Portfolios, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20023 - January 19)

THE OFFITBANK INVESTMENT FUND, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by The OFFITBANK Investment Fund, Inc., et al. for an order pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit a transfer of shares of common stock of OFFITBANK High Yield Fund, a portfolio of The OFFITBANK Investment Fund, Inc., for portfolio securities of The Senior Securities Fund, L.P. (Partnership), after dissolution of the Partnership. (Rel. IC-20024 - January 19)

DAILY MONEY FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 14, 1994 to request a hearing on an application filed by Daily Money Fund, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares. The order would amend a previous order granting an exemption from Sections 18(f)(1), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act to permit applicants to add a conversion feature to an existing multiple class distribution arrangement. (Rel. IC-20027 - January 19)

THE LAUREL FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 14, 1994 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Laurel Funds, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit applicants to offer an unlimited number of classes of shares representing interest in the same portfolio of securities, assess a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares, and waive the CDSC in certain instances. (Rel. IC-20028 - January 19)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC. ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 14, 1994 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), and its nonutility subsidiary company Columbia LNG Corporation (Columbia LNG). Authorization is requested for Columbia LNG to continue to defer principal and interest payments on Columbia LNG's long- and short-term debt to Columbia from March 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994; Columbia LNG to amend its certificate of incorporation to increase its authorized common stock to up to 15 million shares, to change the par value of its stock from \$25 to \$1 per share, and to reduce its stated capital by up to \$24 per share of common stock and to transfer such amount to surplus; Columbia to make a capital contribution to Columbia LNG of up to \$48.1 million of installment promissory notes and short-term debt owed to Columbia by Columbia LNG and up to \$3.9 million of accrued but unpaid interest; Columbia LNG to acquire a 50% partnership interest in exchange for its assets; Columbia LNG to issue, and Columbia to acquire, common stock, \$1 par value, in an aggregate amount up to \$7.0 million through December 31, 1995; and Columbia LNG to acquire up to \$1 million of common stock of one or more wholly-owned special purpose subsidiaries through December 31, 1995. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-41) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange which amends CBOE Rule 6.2, Interpretation and Policy .01 to allow the CBOE to hold an opening rotation in a class of options if the principal market where the underlying security is traded has reported a transaction in the underlying security or disseminated opening quotations for the underlying security and not given an indication of a delayed opening, whichever first occurs. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 24. (Rel. 34-33494)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CHX-93-33) to require certain members of the Exchange to file Form U-5 termination notices with the Exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 24. (Rel. 34-33499)

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-93-05) to add an Interpretation and Policy to Article XX, Rule 23 of the MSE Rules, to allow MSE floor brokers to cross stock on the MSE floor without the possibility of break-up by a specialist under certain circumstances. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 24. (Rel. 34-33500)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-93-42) to amend its disciplinary rules relating to the retention of disciplinary jurisdiction and the settlement of disciplinary actions. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 24. (Rel. 34-33501)
