ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CREATIVE INCOME SYSTEMS AND ERIK SCHRADER PRELIMINARILY ENJOINED

Judge Harold G. Greene, United States District Judge for the District of Columbia, issued an Order preliminarily enjoining Creative Income Systems, a/k/a C.I. Systems (CIS) and Erik E. Schrader (Schrader), the owner and founder, and operator of CIS, from offering or selling the investments set forth in the Commission's complaint. In addition, the order preliminarily enjoins the defendants from violating Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder and from destroying documents. The order also freezes the assets of Schrader and C.I. Systems and requires the defendants to provide an accounting of their assets.

The Commission's complaint alleges that defendants have been, and are, involved in the offer and sale of unregistered securities through the use of fraudulent telephone messages, newspaper advertisements, written materials and oral presentations. DISGORGEMENT ORDERS ENTERED AGAINST ROBERT STOTLER AND JAMES MULKA

The Commission announced that on April 18 Orders of Disgorgement and Termination of Action were entered by consent against Relief Defendants Robert W. Stotler (Stotler) and James W. Mulka (Mulka). Stotler and Mulka consented to the entry of disgorgement orders without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, except for jurisdiction. Mulka was ordered to relinquish any title and beneficial interest in certain stock and debentures of Stotler Group, Inc. (SGI), and Stotler was ordered to relinquish any title and beneficial interest in certain stock of SGI which they obtained as partners of Stotler and Company, the Partnership, and in connection with SGI's August 1988 initial public offering.

The Commission's complaint included a prayer for relief against nineteen Relief Defendants for disgorgement of certain assets to which the Relief Defendants allegedly had no legitimate claim. [SEC v. Thomas M. Egan, et al., 92 C 3480, N.D. Ill.] (LR-14087)

THOMAS EGAN AND STOTLER AND COMPANY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on April 18 Orders of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief were entered by consent against Defendants Thomas M. Egan (Egan) and Stotler and Company (Partnership). Egan is the former president and chief executive officer of Stotler Group, Inc. (SGI) and Stotler and Company, a corporation, and managing partner of the Partnership.

Egan and the Partnership consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint, except for jurisdiction. Egan was barred from acting as an officer or director of any publicly held company and was ordered to relinquish any title and beneficial interest in certain stock of Stotler Group, Inc. (SGI) obtained as a partner of the Partnership and in connection with SGI's August 1988 initial public offering. The Partnership was ordered to relinquish any title and beneficial interest in certain stock of SGI obtained from a former partner upon his withdrawal from the Partnership.

The Commission's complaint alleged that from August 1988 to August 1990, Egan and the Partnership violated and/or aided and abetted violations of the antifraud, broker-dealer registration, books and records, net capital, customer protection, proxy and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. Specifically, the complaint alleged that Egan and the Partnership participated in a scheme to defraud public investors and to deceive the Commission and other regulatory agencies concerning the financial condition of SGI and its subsidiaries. This scheme involved a series of transactions which were structured to conceal self-dealing, create the false appearance of regulatory capital compliance and profitability and misrepresent SGI's true financial condition. INSIDER TRADING COMPLAINT

The Commission announced the filing today of an action in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against Carlos Roman (Roman), his wife, Karla Dorsch, and William E. Dorsch, Karla Dorsch's father, alleging that they engaged in a pattern of repeated violations of the federal securities laws' prohibitions against illegal insider trading, by purchasing the securities of various issuers while in possession of material, nonpublic information concerning imminent tender offers for or other significant, corporate transactions involving those issuers. Defendants are charged with violating Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder.

The complaint alleges that defendants' source of the inside information was Lee A. Haddad (Haddad), a financial analyst employed in the Mergers and Acquisitions Department of Morgan Stanley & Co. Incorporated. After receiving tips from Haddad, Roman and Karla Dorsch purchased the securities of Time, Inc., Squibb Corporation, Combustion Engineering, Inc., LIN Broadcasting Corp., and American General Corporation. After receiving tips, directly or indirectly from Haddad, William Dorsch purchased the securities of Time, Squibb and LIN. In the aggregate, defendants realized approximately \$1.8 million in illegal trading profits. [SEC v. Carlos Roman, et al., USDC, SDNY, 94 Civ. 3621, TPG] (LR-14089)
