## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### CIVIL ACTION AGAINST RAYMOND GOULET, PATRICIA BEATTY AND GULFSHORE REAL ESTATE OF COLLIER COUNTY, INC.

On February 1, the Commission announced that on December 31, 1992, the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida, after trial, issued a final judgment permanently restraining Raymond Goulet (Goulet), Patricia Beatty (Beatty), Gulfshore Real Estate of Collier County, Inc. (Gulfshore) and Gulfshore Entrepreneur Investment Club (GEIC) of Naples, Florida from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission alleged that from approximately October 1991 through September 25, 1992, Gulfshore, Goulet and Beatty, through GEIC, operated a pyramid scheme and made false and misleading statements about GEIC. The Court ordered disgorgement of all monies received by Goulet and Beatty from their activities in connection with the illegal pyramid scheme, as well as all membership fees collected by GEIC. [SEC v. Raymond Goulet, Patricia A. Beatty and Gulfshore Real Estate of Collier County, Inc. individually and doing business as Gulfshore Entrepreneur Investment Club, Civil Action No. 92-293-CIV-FTM-15D, USDC, MD Fla.] (LR-13508)

### EDDIE ANTAR INCARCERATED FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT

On February 2, the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey granted the Securities and Exchange Commission's motion to incarcerate Eddie Antar, former Chief Executive Officer of Crazy Eddie, Inc., pursuant to an unappealable judgment of civil contempt entered three years ago, on February 9, 1990. The Court ordered that Antar be incarcerated until he purges himself of the contempt by complying with the Court's February 9, 1990 order requiring him to return \$52 million to the United States.

The SEC sought the return of the \$52 million after bringing an action against Antar in September 1989, alleging that he and others had unlawfully obtained tens of millions of dollars as the result of a massive securities and financial fraud perpetrated at Crazy Eddie. In July 1990, the SEC obtained a Final Judgment against Antar. The Final Judgment, including interest, now amounts to over \$84 million. [SEC v. Eddie Antar, Sam E. Antar, Mitchell Antar, Isaac Kairey, David Panoff, Eddie Gindi and Kathleen Morin, USDC for the District of New Jersey, Newark Division, Civil Action No. 89-3773, NHP] (LR-13509)

#### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 12 to comment on the applications of the Midwest Stock Exchange, Philadelphia Stock Exchange and Pacific Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one issue each which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. #### UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Boston Stock Exchange - 18 issues (Rel. 34-31811); Pacific Stock Exchange - 6 issues (Rel. 34-31814); Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 18 issues (Rel. 34-31815); and Midwest Stock Exchange - 21 issues (Rel. 34-31816).

#### WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 24 to comment on the application of Sunrise Technologies, Inc. to withdraw its Common Stock, No Par Value, from listing and registration on the Pacific Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-31812)

#### DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration International Veronex Resources Ltd., Common Stock, No Par Value. (Rel. 34-31813)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-45) to increase the position and exercise limits currently attainable for options on the Wilshire Small Cap Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31793)

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-08) to make permanent limitations that exclude competing market makers from receiving an additional system credit for certain market orders. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31796)

The Participants Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-92-14) relating to the designation by PTC of certain securities guaranteed by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as eligible securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31804)

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-92-46) to disclaim New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) liability for Amex member firm use of the electronic display book which was recently licensed from the NYSE for use on the Amex trading floor. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31805)

The Participants Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-92-12) that would allow the Collateral Loan Facility to be used for transfers of a security interest from a Limited Purpose Account. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 8. (Rel. 34-31810)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted permanent approval on an accelerated basis to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-92-45) that provides the Exchange with authority to trade Portfolio Depository Receipts (PDRs) in fractions of 1/32's. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31794)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-20) to amend permanently Rule 104.10(6) to permit specialists to "reliquify" a dealer position by selling "long" on a zero-minus tick, or by purchasing to cover a "short" position on a zero-plus tick, without Floor Official approval. The amendments also emphasize the specialist's affirmative role in providing stabilizing dealer participation to the marketplace where reliquification may be required to facilitate the maintenance of a fair and orderly market. (Rel. 34-31797)

#### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-93-07) to decrease its transaction charges by providing a system credit for certain market participants, reduce the odd-lot specialist charge and create a new specialist charge has become effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31795)

#### TEMPORARY APPROVAL ON AN ACCELERATED BASIS OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval on a temporary basis to a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-92-11) relating to the extension of temporary approval of the Institutional Participant Services Program. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 1. (Rel. 34-31798)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-92-13) to enable the Exchange to list and trade options on the Standard & Poor's 100 and 500 stock indexes that expire on the first business day of the month following the end of each calendar quarter. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 8. (Rel. 34-31800)
