ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED AGAINST J. H. AYRES & CO. INC. AND JAMES AYRES

The Commission entered an Order Making Findings against J. H. Ayres & Co. Inc. (Ayres & Company), a registered investment adviser located in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and against its president, James H. Ayres (Ayres), ordering them to permanently cease and desist from violating Section 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act) and Rule 206(4)-1 thereunder. In entering the Order the Commission accepted an offer submitted by Ayres & Company and Ayres wherein they neither admitted nor denied the allegations set forth in the Order for Public Administrative Proceedings and consented to the entry of the Order and Findings. Among other things, the Order finds that Ayres & Company violated provisions of the Advisers Act by providing false and misleading information about itself to financial publications that during the years 1988 - 1992 it had between 178 and 193 clients when in fact it had only 4 clients; and, that it had amounts of client monies under management ranging up to \$2.5 billion when in fact it had no more than \$1.7 million under management. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-92-40) to permit the CBOE to increase, in one or more classes of multiply-traded equity options, the size of orders eligible for entry into the CBOE's Retail Automated Execution System (RAES) to the extent necessary to match the size of orders eligible for entry into any other exchange's automated execution system, and to reroute for non-automated handling any bids or offers entered into RAES at prices inferior to the current best bid or offer in any other market. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 8. (Rel. 34-31827)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted permanent approval on an accelerated basis to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-92-29) to enable the Exchange to list and trade options on the Major Market, Institutional and Standard & Poor's Midcap stock indexes that expire on the first business day of the month following the end of each calendar quarter. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-31844)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-02) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, which provides for incorporating into Exchange rules a list of the designated reporting authorities for the various indexes that underlie index options contracts traded on the Exchange, has become effective upon filing. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 15. (Rel. 34-31849)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-92-27) to increase, under certain circumstances, the number of consecutive elected terms that a governor may serve on the Amex Board of Governors. (Rel. 34-31850)
