CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST AMERICAN CAPITAL INVESTMENTS, INC., STEPHEN MURPHY AND OTHERS

The Commission announced on September 13 that the Honorable Consuelo B. Marshall, U.S. District Court Judge for the Central District of California, issued a Preliminary Injunction against American Capital Investments, Inc. (ACI), Stephen J. Murphy (Murphy) and Kenneth A. Sorensen (Sorensen) from certain violations of the federal securities laws. The Court ordered an asset freeze against ACI and Murphy, and appointed a permanent receiver over ACI. The Commission's complaint alleges fraud in the offer and sale of unregistered securities by ACI, Murphy, Sorensen, and Richard D. Otto (Otto), and Adfin Corporation (Adfin). Previously, on September 2, 1993 the Court issued a temporary restraining order and appointed a temporary receiver over ACI.

The evidence obtained by the Commission shows that from August 1992 through the present, the defendants fraudulently raised approximately \$14.5 million from about 180 investors nationwide. The defendants solicited individuals by cold-calling and contacting those who responded to Murphy's advertisements in the national media, selling books written by Murphy such as One Up on Trump and Trickle "Up" Economics. The complaint alleges that the defendants misrepresented to investors the purported returns, use of proceeds and misrepresented ACI's poor financial condition. [SEC v. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST SHERI COHEN AND JOSEPH PERGOLA

On September 24, the Commission announced the filing of an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York seeking a permanent injunction against Sheri Cohen and Joseph Pergola for violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Simultaneously with the filing of the Commission's complaint, and without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the complaint, Pergola has consented to the entry of a final judgment of permanent injunction, covering all of the provisions which the Commission alleged were violated.

The Commission's complaint alleges that from August 1990 until February 1992, Cohen and Pergola, operating as Distribution International, Inc. (DII), engaged in fraud in the purchase and sale of securities by soliciting investments in credit card-operated fax machines, to be installed, operated, maintained and promoted by DII. The complaint alleges that between 1990 and 1992, DII received payments totalling approximately \$450,000. The complaint further alleges that Cohen and Pergola made material misrepresentations regarding the revenues to be derived from the operation of the fax machines, the installation of the fax machines and the locations at which the machines were to be installed. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by EUA Cogenex Corporation (Cogenex), a wholly owned nonutility subsidiary company of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company. Cogenex is authorized to issue and sell long-term unsecured notes in an amount not to exceed \$50 million through December 31, 1995. (Rel. 35-25888)

The Commission granted approval to a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-91-38) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange regarding the administration of the Exchange's Floor Member Qualification Examination. Specifically, the Commission has approved

the use of the Floor Member Examination for the purpose of ensuring that CBOE floor members have the requisite knowledge, skill and ability to carry out their responsibilities consistent with the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 27. (Rel. 34-32943)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-32) filed by the New York Stock Exchange relating to the listing and trading of a hybrid security exchangeable for common stock. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 27. (Rel. 34-32950)
