## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO TESTIFY

Chairman Breeden will testify on Tuesday, May 7, beginning at 10:00 a.m. before the Senate Banking Committee. The subject of the hearing, which will be in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building, is S. 543 and S. 713.

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### NOTICE OF PERMANENT SUSPENSION ENTERED AGAINST CECIL MATHIS

On May 3, the Commission announced that Cecil S. Mathis has been permanently suspended, pursuant to Rule 2(e)(3)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, from appearing or practicing as an attorney before the Commission. The permanent suspension is based upon an order of permanent injunction, to which Mathis consented, entered on January 7, 1991 [SEC v. Lifeline Healthcare Group, Inc., Civil Action No. 89 C-964 B, N.D. Oklahoma]. Mathis is a former Assistant Regional Administrator of the Commission's Fort Worth Regional Office. (Rel. 34-29164)

### MICHAEL BEATTY BARRED

The Commission announced that it has ordered that Michael C. Beatty (Beatty) be barred from association with any broker or dealer. Beatty failed to answer an Order which instituted administrative proceedings against him on August 20, 1990. The Commission found, based on the Order Instituting Proceedings, that on June 1, 1990, Beatty was permanently enjoined, by default, by the U.S. District Court for the District of Minnesota, from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission also found that Beatty raised over \$4 million in the offer and sale of interests in four limited partnerships, ITS-1985-I, Ltd., ITS-1986-VIII, Ltd., ITS-1987-X, Ltd., and ITS-1987-XI, Ltd., and unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes issued by Investment Tax Services, Inc. The Commission also found that Beatty made materially false and misleading statements and omissions in the sale of these securities concerning the safety of the investments, the use of proceeds, his disciplinary history and the risks associated with the investments. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### COMMISSION FILES MOTION FOR DISMISSAL OF INJUNCTIVE ACTION PENDING AGAINST TRANS GLOBAL HOLDINGS, INC.

On May 6, the Commission announced the filing of a Motion for Dismissal of the injunctive action pending against Trans Global Holdings, Inc. (Trans Global) in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. The Commission moved for the dismissal because Trans Global no longer exists as an operating corporation, and its Certificate of Incorporation in the State of Delaware was forfeited for failure to appoint an agent. On April 19, 1991, in the same action, Judge Michael B. Mukasey permanently enjoined defendant Michael Stern (Stern), chairman and president of Trans Global, from violations of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Without admitting or denying the facts alleged in the Commission's complaint, Stern consented to the entry of the Final Judgment.

On May 23, 1989, Stern and Trans Global issued a press release stating, among other things, that Stern was "in the final stages of putting together a group of investors" who would provide up to \$600 million in equity to finance cash acquisitions of NWA, Inc. (NWA) and Pan Am Corporation (Pan Am). The press release further stated that "both a major Wall Street investment banking firm and a domestic banking institution had indicated an interest in participating by arranging for the debt." The complaint alleged that these statements were false or misleading and that the press release, taken as a whole, was materially false and misleading. [SEC v. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### MUTUAL BENEFIT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The Mutual Benefit Life Insurance Company, Mutual Benefit Variable Contract Account-11 of Mutual Benefit Life Insurance Company (Account), Directed Services, Inc. and Dreyfus Service Corporation (collectively, Applicants) from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. Applicants are exempted to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under a Deferred Variable Annuity certificate issued pursuant to the Deferred Master Group Contract. The order also exempts Applicants from Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a premium-based sales load from the accumulation value of the Account. ### NATIONAL HOME LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 31 to request a hearing on an application by National Home Life Assurance Company of New York, National Home Life Assurance Company of New York Separate Account B (Account) and the Vanguard Variable Insurance Fund. The application is for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions would be granted to the extent

necessary to permit the deduction from the Account of the mortality and expense risk charges imposed under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-18133 - May 6)

#### THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 28 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company, an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company. The proposal seeks to lease and purchase certain electric utility assets from The Farmington River Power Company, and its parent, The Stanley Works, for a total consideration of \$7.5 million. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
