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### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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THE BOSTON COMPANY INDEX AND BLUE CHIP TRUST  
PUTNAM CAPITAL FUND  
UNIFIED MUNICIPAL FUND  
PUTNAM CORPORATE CASH TRUST - ADJUSTABLE RATE PREFERRED PORTFOLIO

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The Boston Company Index and Blue Chip Trust, Putnam Capital Fund, Unified Municipal Fund, Inc., and Putnam Corporate Cash Trust - Adjustable Rate Preferred Portfolio have ceased to be investment companies. **ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES**

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
