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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

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PETER ROBINSON APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND POLICY FORMULATION

Chairman Richard C. Breeden today announced the appointment of Peter M. Robinson as Director of the Office of Public Affairs and Policy Formulation at the Commission. In his new position, Mr. Robinson will be responsible for press relations, periodical Commission publications and various public information activities at the agency. In addition, he will supervise drafting of speeches for the Chairman of the Commission and development of policy initiatives.

Mr. Robinson replaces Gary E. Fendler, former Director of Communications, who had been serving as Acting Director of the Commission's Office of Public Affairs. Mr. Fendler recently accepted an appointment as Associate Commissioner of Public Affairs for the United States Food and Drug Administration. (Press Rel. 91-67)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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LIQUID INSTITUTIONAL RESERVES, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Liquid Institutional Reserves (Trust), et al for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from the provisions of Section 18(f)(1), 18(g) and 18(i). Applicants seek relief to permit the various series of the Trust to issue to sell two classes of securities that would be identical in all respects except for differences related to shareholder services plan expenses, voting rights, exchange privileges and class designation. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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THE KANSAS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on an amended application by The Kansas Power and Light Company (KPL), a Kansas combination electric and gas utility. KPL proposes to acquire all of the outstanding capital stock of Kansas Gas and Electric Company, a Kansas electric-utility company and a public-utility holding company exempt from registration under

Section 3(a)(2) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2. KPL also requests an order of exemption under Section 3(a)(2) from all provisions of the Act except Section 9(a)(2). (Rel. 35-25410)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (CNG), a registered holding company, to acquire up to and including 20,930 shares of its common stock pursuant to an option in CNG's Long-Term Incentive Plan (Plan). Under the option, participants who have restricted stock awards may elect to have shares of common stock withheld upon termination of such restrictions in order to satisfy mandatory tax withholding obligations. **ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES**

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column - 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
