CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

H.K. FREELAND & CO., INC.; HOVHANNES K. FREELAND PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission announced the filing, on Nov. 26, of a civil injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against H.K. Freeland & Co., Inc. (H.K. Freeland) of Long Beach, Calif., and Hovhanness K. Freeland (Freeland) of Lakewood, Calif. The Complaint seeks final judgments of permanent injunction and disgorgement against Freeland and Freeland & Co., the appointment of an equity receiver to liquidate Freeland & Co., and an asset freeze against Freeland & Co. The Complaint charges that Freeland & Co. violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Sections 10(b), 15(b)(1), 15(c)(1), 15(c)(3), and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-3, 10b-5, 15b1-2, 15c1-2, 15c3-1, and 17a-5 thereunder. It is also charged that Freeland violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and aided and abetted Freeland & Co.'s violations of Sections 10(b), 15(b)(1), 15(c)(1), 15(c)(3), and 17(a) of the Exchange Act, and Rules 10b-3, 15b1-2, 15c1-2, 15c3-1, and 17a-5 thereunder.

Simultaneous with the filing of the Complaint, Freeland and Freeland & Co. consented to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief On Consent granting the relief sought in the Commission's Complaint except as to monetary issues. [SEC v. H.K. Freeland & Co., Inc. and Hovhanness K. Freeland, a/k/a John Freeland, Civil Action No. 91-7986, SDNY, Nov. 26, 1991] (LR-13103)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THOMSON MCKINNON ACCUMULATION PLAN TRUST

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by the: Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-91-17) and, on an accelerated basis, an identical proposal filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-91-14) to permit the Exchanges to implement one-year pilot programs allowing approved customers with qualified portfolios to effect and maintain in cash accounts debit put spread transactions in broad-based index options with European-style exercise (Rel. 34-29992); and Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-91-18) to establish procedures for the CBOE's intraday trade match system (Rel. 34-30000) and (SR-CBOE-90-06) to institute a fee for the submission of trade information to the CBOE later than two hours after the time of execution of a trade (Rel. 34-30001).

NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-27) to introduce, for trading, narrow-based index options based on an index of bank stocks developed by Keefe, Bruyette & Woods, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, and the PHLX. Publication of the notice is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of Dec. 2. (Rel. 34-30002)

The National Association of Securities Dealers has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-64) to amend Part IV of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to adopt a new annual fee for domestic NASDAQ National Market System and regular NASDAQ issuers. The NASD proposes to partially implement the new annual fee during calendar year 1992, and to fully implement it in January, 1993. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of Dec. 2. (Rel. 34-30003)
