ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PHILIP A. BERNICK BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Philip A. Bernick, formerly a principal of a registered broker-dealer of Denver, Colorado. Bernick consented to the Order which finds that Bernick: (1) submitted for publication quotations for Laser Arms Corporation common stock, although the information required by Rule 15c2-11 of the Securities Exchange Act, which he had received, had not been obtained from a source that he had a reasonable basis to believe was reliable; (2) participated directly in the sale of unregistered Laser Arms common stock; and (3) on July 20, 1987, pleaded guilty to conspiracy to obstruct justice (United States v. Marshall A. Zolp, et al., No. 86-CR-0299 (D.N.J. July 20, 1987)) and received a three-year prison sentence (suspended), fined \$2,000, ordered to make restitution of \$10,000 and to perform community service, and was placed on probation for five years.

The Order also bars Bernick from association with any broker, dealer, investment advisor, investment company, or municipal securities dealer, with the proviso that he may apply to become so associated after three years from the date of the Order or upon the completion of probation, whichever occurs later. FRANK R. GRILLO BARRED

The New York Regional Office announced that the Commission has simultaneously instituted and settled administrative proceedings against Frank R. Grillo of Flushing, New York, and upon his consent barred Grillo from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company. The Commission found that Grillo had been permanently enjoined upon his consent from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws in an action styled "SEC v. Frank R. Grillo, et al., Civil Action 89-1453 (D.N.J.)." The Commission also found that Grillo had failed reasonably to supervise two persons subject to his supervision, with a view toward preventing their violations of the securities laws. Grillo neither admitted nor denied the finding that he failed to supervise the two individuals at Walter Capital Corp., a defunct broker-dealer which underwrote an initial public offering of Regional Funding Corp. common stock in 1984. Notices have been issued giving interested persons until January 16, 1990, to request a hearing on applications filed by VOYAGER VARIABLE ANNUITY ACCOUNT C (Applicant) and

VOYAGER VARIABLE ANNUITY FUND (Applicant), seeking orders under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act, declaring that Applicants have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-17281 and 17282, respectively - Dec. 22)

Orders have been issued under Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act, on application of: FIRST INVESTORS DISCOVERY FUND, INC., ET AL., approving the substitution of First Investors International Securities Fund, Inc. for the shares of First Investors Discovery Fund, Inc. as the underlying shares of First Investors Single Payment and Periodic Payment Plan for Investment in First Investors Discovery Fund, Inc. (Rel. IC-17283 - Dec. 26); and FIRST INVESTORS FUND FOR GROWTH INC., ET AL., approving the substitution of the shares of First Investors International Securities Fund, Inc. for shares of First Investors Fund for Growth, Inc. as the underlying shares of First Investors Single Payment and Periodic Payment Plans for Investment in First Investors Fund for Growth, Inc. (Rel. IC-17284 - Dec. 26)

AMERICAN TAX CREDIT PROPERTIES II L.P.

An order has been issued on an application filed by American Tax Credit Properties II L.P. (Partnership) and its managing general partner, Richman Tax Credit Properties II L.P., exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. The Partnership will operate as a "two-tier" limited partnership by investing in other limited partnerships that, in turn, will engage in the ownership, operation, and possibly development or rehabilitation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-17285 - Dec. 27)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The International Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-ISCC-89-01) filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act that would modify ISCC's link agreement with Centrale de Livraison de Valeurs Mobilieres to permit ISCC to transmit data in connection with the National Association of Securities Dealers' proposed trading system, PORTAL. (For a description of the PORTAL trading system, see Rel. 34-27470 [November 24, 1989], 54 FR 49164). Notice of the proposed rule change should appear in the Federal Register during the week of December 25. (Rel. 34-27563)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-89-22) that permits the Amex to list index warrants based on the Nikkei Stock Average. (Rel. 34-27565)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-49) has filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 that would amend certain sections of Articles II and III of the NASD Code of Procedure, concerning presentation of evidence and review of

disciplinary actions. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 25, 1989. (Rel. 34-27567)

DENIAL OF STAY REQUEST

The Commission denied a request on behalf of the market makers of the Pacific Stock Exchange's (PSE) Options Floor Post X-17 pursuant to Section 19(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act for a stay of the PSE action reallocating several options to other PSE posts. (Rel. 34-27568)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
