HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RULE 52 ADOPTED

The Commission today adopted Rule 52 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act exempting the issuance and sale of certain securities by public utility subsidiary companies of registered holding companies from the requirement of a declaration under Section 6(a) of the Act under specified conditions. Rule 52 also includes an exemption, in accordance with Section 9(c)(3) to permit parent holding companies to acquire, without prior Commission authorization, the securities their subsidiaries would be permitted to issue under Rule 52. (See also the proposed revision of Rule 52, below, released for comment today.) (Rel. 35-25058)

PROPOSED REVISION TO RULE 52

The Commission today released for comment a proposed revision to Rule 52 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act to eliminate certain of the specific conditions that are now part of the rule. (See notice of adoption of Rule 52 above.) Comments must be received in triplicate before 90 days after the date of publication in the Federal Register. Comments should be submitted to Jonathan G. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 9 to request a hearing on a proposal by General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), General Portfolios Corporation (GPC), subsidiary of GPU, and Energy Initiatives, Incorporated (EII), subsidiary of GPC, whereby EII will be engaged in preliminary project development and administrative activities in connection with: (1) qualifying cogeneration facilities and qualifying small power production facilities; and (2) load management and energy storage system projects. GPU and GPC propose to make investments in EII through December 31, 1992, in an aggregate amount of up to \$60 million, in the form of: (1) capital contributions and (2) unsecured borrowings by GPC from commercial banks, insurance companies and other institutional lenders. GPC further proposes to organize and acquire for \$1,000 all of the common stock of a new subsidiary, Fuels Corp. EII further proposes to change its state of incorporation to Delaware by a statutory merger of EII and a newly formed Delaware corporation which would be a wholly-owned subsidiary of GPC. PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-29) proposing that the rules governing the operational procedures for Retail Automatic Execution System (RAES) in Standards & Poor's 500 Index Options (SPX) be approved on a permanent basis. The Commission also approved, on an accelerated basis, the portion of the rule change that extends the CBOE's operational procedures for RAES in SPX options on a pilot basis. Publication of the approval order is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 19. (Rel. 34-27810)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
