INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ACM HIGH INCOME FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that ACM High Income Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17421 - Apr. 11)

TECHNOLOGY FUNDING VENTURE PARTNERS V, AN AGGRESSIVE GROWTH FUND, L.P.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Technology Funding Venture Partners V, An Aggressive Growth Fund, L.P. (Partnership), Technology Funding Inc., and Technology Funding Ltd., determining that: (1) the independent general partners of the Partnership are not "interested persons" of the Partnership, the other general partners, or the principal underwriter of the Partnership solely by reason of their status as general partners of the Partnership and co-partners of the other general partners of the Partnership; and (2) no limited partner owning less than five percent of the units of limited partnership interest in the Partnership is an "affiliated person" of the Partnership or any of its partners solely by reason of being a limited partner of the Partnership and a co-partner of the other limited partners and the general partners. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-89-07) to shorten the period for filing claims against MSE specialists' transaction reports from five business days to three business days. (Rel. 34-27882)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved on an accelerated basis a Chicago Board Options Exchange (CBOE) proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-90-03) to allow members of the Index Floor Procedure Committee to perform the functions of a Floor Official in the Standard & Poors' 100 Stock Index Option (OEX) and Standard & Poors' 500 Stock Index Option (SPX) trading crowds for the purpose of enforcing operational and trading decorum policies. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change was filed by the Pacific Clearing Corporation (SR-PCC-90-02) relating to amendments to post clearing charges. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected to be made during the week of April 16. (Rel. 34-27884)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
