## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ENTERED AGAINST DSC COMMUNICATIONS AND DELMAR G. CARTWRIGHT

The Commission yesterday entered an Order Instituting Proceedings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Findings and Order of the Commission against DSC Communications Corporation and Delmar G. Cartwright, a vice president of DSC. The Order finds that DSC materially overstated its net sales and net income for the fourth quarter of fiscal 1984 and the first and second quarters of fiscal 1985 by engaging in improper revenue recognition practices concerning the sales of equipment maintained in "pools" for customers when the customers had made no commitment to take any of the equipment in the pools in the particular quarters when DSC recognized revenue from the equipment.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's facts, findings, or conclusions (1) DSC consented to the Order finding that it violated the books and records, internal control, and periodic reporting provisions of the Exchange Act; and (2) Cartwright consented to the Order finding that he violated Rule 13b2-1 of the Exchange Act (false books and records) and was a cause of DSC's failure to comply with the periodic reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. ### ORDER FOR SANCTIONS ENTERED BY DEFAULT AGAINST S. MASON ACKROYD

The Commission entered an Order against S. Mason Ackroyd in public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, finding her in default and imposing sanctions. Ackroyd is a registered representative formerly associated with G.C. George Securities, a Spokane, Washington broker-dealer; she now resides in San Jose, California. Ackroyd was found in default because of her failure to respond to the Order Instituting Proceedings.

The Order finds that Ackroyd was enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington on October 20, 1987, prohibiting future violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Order further finds that Ackroyd willfully violated those same provisions in connection with the distribution of unregistered stock of Golden Bear Resources, Ltd., a Canadian corporation. Ackroyd made false statements of material fact during the distribution, and omitted to disclose material facts, concerning a purported acquisition by Golden Bear of oil land in Alaska. The Order bars Ackroyd from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-26414)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST ROCKY MOUNT UNDERGARMENT CO., INC., OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint on January 9 in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina seeking to enjoin Rocky Mount Undergarment Co., Inc. (RMUC), David Greenberg, co-founder and former President, Chief Executive Officer, and Chairman of the Board of RMUC, Gilbert Jerome Samuels, Senior Vice President of RMUC, Stretchlon Industries, Inc., and Richard Sarmiento, Vice President and Manager of Stretchlon, from violating and aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, reporting, books and records, and internal control provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Complaint alleges, in part, that RMUC, Greenberg, and Samuels, aided and abetted by Stretchlon and Sarmiento, engaged in conduct which resulted in the material overstatement of RMUC's inventories and net income in its 1985 year-end financial statements. It also alleges that Greenberg and Samuels directed RMUC employees to inflate figures on count sheets reflecting RMUC's year-end physical inventory levels. It further alleges that Sarmiento and Stretchlon submitted to RMUC's auditors a letter falsely confirming the amount of inventory Stretchlon held for RMUC at year-end 1985. Simultaneously, RMUC, Greenberg, Samuels, and Stretchlon, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction. The case against Sarmiento is pending. (SEC v. Rocky Mount Undergarment Co., Inc., et al. USDC EDNC, Raleigh Division, Civil Action No. 89-014-CIV-5). (LR-11960; AAER-21)

### CEDAR COAL COMPANY; MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE, INC.
