TRADING SUSPENSIONS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF CHASE MEDICAL GROUP, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Chase Medical Group, Inc. for the period beginning at 11:00 a.m. (EST) on January 16 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on January 25, 1989.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Chase Medical because of questions concerning unusual market activity in those securities and because of questions concerning an accumulation of over 50 percent of the company's outstanding securities by a broker-dealer and certain of its customers and the resulting potential impact on the market for Chase Medical's securities. The Commission also ordered the suspension because of the failure of several of these people to make payments to a broker-dealer in connection with the acquisition and maintenance of such securities as requested. TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF FUN FOODS, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Fun Foods, Inc. for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on January 17 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EST) on January 26, 1989.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Fun Foods in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the financial condition of the company, its current management, the identity of current officers and directors, and the location of corporate headquarters. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

A. LARRY LINDSEY, OTHERS PLEAD GUILTY

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of California announced that on January 9 A. Larry Lindsey and Robert C. Simmons were sentenced based on their guilty pleas. Lindsey had pled guilty to violations of 18 U.S.C. § 1341 (mail fraud) and 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy); he was sentenced to three years' imprisonment and five years' probation and ordered to pay \$700,000 in restitution. Simmons had pled guilty to a violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7206(1) (willful filing of a false tax return); he was sentenced to five years' probation. The remaining defendant, Alan E. Kushnick, also entered a guilty plea (to violations of 18 U.S.C. § 371), and his sentencing has yet to be held. The criminal action is related to an earlier Commission case addressing violative limited partnership offerings and the fraudulent takeover of a public company. (U.S. v. A. Larry Lindsey, et al., CR No. 87-0287-MHP, NDCA). (LR-11962)

BETTIE J. JANIS SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Florida and the Miami Branch Office announced that on December 20, 1988, U.S. District Court Judge Eugene P. Spellman, Southern District of Florida, sentenced Bettie J. Janis, formerly of Miami, Florida, to two years imprisonment and five years probation in connection with her earlier plea of guilty to mail fraud and securities fraud. Janis was also ordered to make restitution in the amount of \$27,000 to two investors, and forbidden to work in the area of investment advice until the end of her probation.

According to the indictment, Janis defrauded 17 investors of at least \$290,000 between January 1983 and February 1984. Janis, among other things, misappropriated investment funds and made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts in connection with the sale of interests in an oil and gas limited partnership. The misrepresentation and omissions, among other things, concerned the intended use of the proceeds, the performance of Janis's prior oil and gas ventures, the financial condition of Janis Inc., and the risk involved with the investment.

The Commission, in October 1984, barred Janis from association with any broker dealer, investment adviser, or investment company. (U.S. v. Bettie J. Janis, Indictment No. 88-021-CR-SPELLMAN, SDFL). (LR-11963)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN CAPITAL WORLD INVESTMENT SERIES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Capital World Investment Series, Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16751 Jan. 11)

BANQUE NATIONALE DE PARIS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Banque Nationale de Paris, a French commercial bank exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of its equity securities in the United States. PACIFIC AMERICAN FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pacific American Fund, Westcore Trust, ALPS Securities Inc., and Fidelity Distributors Corp. for an order approving certain proposed offer of exchange of shares on a basis other than their respective net asset value per share at the time of exchange and the imposition of a nominal administrative fee of \$7.50 on such exchanges. GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION; ALLEGHENY POWER SERVICE COMPANY; ALLEGHENY GENERATING COMPANY; KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 6 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24804, dated January 12: GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION (GPU) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed), and Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec), to issue, sell and renew their short-term notes and/or commercial paper, from time to time through March 31, 1992, in outstanding amounts not to exceed charter limitations in the case of JCP&L, Met-Ed, and Penelec, and \$200 million in the case of GPU; ALLEGHENY POWER SERVICE COMPANY - subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to issue notes from time to time through December 31, 1990 in the aggregate principal amount of \$7.5 million; ALLEGHENY GENERATING COMPANY - subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to issue to dealers, from time to time through March 31, 1991, under an exception from competitive bidding, up to \$200 million of commercial paper, which shall not mature after September 30, 1991. Merrill Lynch Money Markets, Inc. and Citibank, N.A. have been designated by Allegheny Generating as its commercial paper dealers; and KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to sell certain utility assets to GTE South Incorporated.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-88-6) to adopt a Policy Statement on Market Closings that provides for a trading halt in all equities traded on the CSE in conjunction with trading halts at other U.S. markets caused by the implementation of coordinated circuit breaker procedures. Such procedures will be implemented if the Dow Jones Industrial Average declines 250 or 400 points from its previous day's close. (Rel. 34-26440)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

The Options Price Reporting Authority submitted a proposed amendment to the Options Price Reporting Plan (File No. S7-820) establishing a fee to be paid by vendors who furnish a dial-up computer market data service to their customers. (Rel. 34-26441)
