COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

GENERAL COUNSEL ISSUES ORDER AFFIRMING DENIAL OF FOIA REQUEST

The General Counsel sent a letter to David J. Lewis affirming the decision of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Officer to deny Mr. Lewis access to two staff memoranda under the FOIA. The General Counsel concluded that disclosure of the memoranda was not required by the Government in the Sunshine Act, that the memoranda were privileged, and that the privilege was not waived by public reference to the memoranda during an open Commission meeting, particularly where the Commission did not adopt the memoranda as its decision. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST RONALD D. WHEELER, SR.

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 6 the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada entered a Preliminary Injunction against Ronald D. Wheeler, Sr. On February 3, the Commission filed a 12-count Complaint against Wheeler and others alleging, among other things, violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Wheeler was president of Stoneridge Securities, Inc., a Las Vegas, Nevada penny stock broker.

The Complaint alleged that Wheeler and other defendants distributed stock of CTI Technical, Inc. and Composite Design, Inc. through fraudulent means. Further, it alleged a scheme by which defendants manipulated the price of CTI and Composite in after market trading. On February 21, the Commission was granted a Temporary Restraining Order based upon ongoing violations of the antifraud provisions by Wheeler in offers and sales of Composite stock. The Preliminary Injunction was entered on March 6. (SEC v. Stoneridge Securities, Inc., et al., DNV, No. CV-S-89-096, filed February 3, 1989). (LR-12054)

WILLIAM S. HOGLUND TEMPORARILY RESTRAINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on April 4 U.S. District Court Judge Thomas P. Griesa, Southern District of New York, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against William S. Hoglund, of Greenwich, Connecticut, prohibiting him from committing further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Court also froze Hoglund's assets and ordered that he provide an accounting.

The Complaint for injunctive relief, filed the same day, alleged that Hoglund, an individual registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer, obtained approximately \$1,800,000 from investors for the purpose of executing various trading strategies in his market maker accounts on various securities exchanges. Contrary to his representations, the Commission charged that Hoglund accepted funds from investors, and then converted, dissipated, and secreted these funds for his own personal use, rather than investing them as promised. Furthermore, the Complaint alleged that Hoglund currently owes investors at least \$1,560,000. (SEC v. William S. Hoglund, USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 89 Civ. 2222, LBS). (LR-12055)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NOMURA MORTGAGE CAPITAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Nomura Mortgage Capital Corporation for a conditional order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and the sale of residual interests. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing The Southern Company, a registered holding company, and two of its public-utility subsidiaries, Gulf Power Company and Mississippi Power Company, through March 31, 1991: (1) for Southern to make capital contributions to Gulf, Mississippi, and Georgia Power Company, another Southern subsidiary, in the aggregate amounts of \$10 million, \$10 million, and \$20 million, respectively; and (2) for Gulf and Mississippi to issue and sell from time to time, up to the aggregate principal of \$50 million for Gulf and \$120 million for Mississippi, short-term notes to banks and commercial paper to dealers. In addition, Mississippi proposes to submit to holders of its outstanding preferred stock for consideration and action at a special meeting of such holders to be held on or about May 16 a proposal that Mississippi be authorized, until July 1, 1999, to issue or assume unsecured debt having maturities of less than ten years in excess of 10% of capital stock, surplus, and secured debt. Jurisdiction has been reserved over all other matters proposed in the application-declaration pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24850 - Mar. 30)
