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CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

LEWIS LEEDS ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on April 12 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida entered a Judgment against Lewis Leeds, a Miami securities trader, permanently enjoining him and ordering him to disgorge profits derived from his transactions in the securities of Capt. Crab's Take-Away, Inc., a Florida franchisor. The Judgment enjoins Leeds from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and from aiding and abetting violations of Section 15(c)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 15c1-2. In addition, the Judgment requires Leeds to disgorge \$100,000, to be placed in the custody of a Receiver for distribution to investors who purchased Capt. Crab securities from 1982-1984. The Judgment was entered as part of a settlement agreement in which Leeds neither admitted nor denied the Commission's allegations.

Based on the Court's entry of an Injunction against Leeds, the Commission entered an administrative order barring Leeds from association with any broker or dealer for 45 days [see Release 34-26725]. (SEC v. Capt. Crab, Inc., et al., SDFL, Civil Action No. 87-0100-ALH). (LR-12063)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

APPLICATION FOR CRIMINAL CONTEMPT FILED AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE ENTERED AGAINST WILLIAM ROBERT METTE'

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Middle District of Florida announced that on March 22 U.S. District Court Judge William Castagna, Middle District of Florida, ordered that the Commission's and U.S. Attorney's joint Application For An Order To Show Cause Why William Robert Mette' Should Not Be Punished For Criminal Contempt (Application) be filed, and issued an Order To Show Cause Why William Robert Mette' Should Not Be Punished For Criminal Contempt.

The Application alleges that, among other allegations, on May 19, 1988 Mette' was permanently enjoined from further violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws; that since about June 1 through October 19, 1988, Mette' willfully violated the permanent injunction by offering and selling unregistered common stock of Centuri Mining Corporation, Inc.; and in that connection misrepresented Mette's background, Centuri's equipment and operations, and the commercial feasibility of a proposed mining project by Centuri.

A hearing was set for April 14 for Mette' to show cause why he should not be adjudged in criminal contempt. (U.S. v. William Robert Mette', aka Robert William Mette', Case No. 89-30 CR-T-15B, MDPL). (LR-12060)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GGIA FUNDING CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting GGIA Funding Corporation from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with its issuance of bonds to facilitate System Energy Resources, Inc. in certain leveraged lease transactions. (Rel. IC-16910 - Apr. 11)

DIMENSIONAL FUND ADVISORS INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Dimensional Fund Advisors Inc. (DFA), a registered investment adviser, declaring a presumption of control of DFA by a person who owns more than 25% of DFA's voting securities to be rebutted by evidence. (Rel. IC-16911 - Apr. 12)

MIDWEST GROUP STATE TAX EXEMPT TRUST

An order has been issued declaring that Midwest Group State Tax Exempt Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16912 - Apr. 12)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing additional fees and expenses in connection with a proposal by Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to effect a series of transactions whereby Oglethorpe Power Corporation would acquire an interest, increasing over time, in Georgia Power's Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project. (Rel. 35-24857 - Apr. 10)

CSW ENERGY, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by CSW Energy, Inc. (Energy), and its parent company, Central and South West Corporation (CSW), whereby CSW will purchase additional common stock issued by Energy or make capital contributions to Energy in amounts up to \$1 million to enable Energy to finance certain preliminary expenses in connection with a proposed cogeneration facility to be located in Newark, New Jersey. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue and sell from time to time through December 31, 1990 up to \$500 million of first mortgage bonds. (Rel. 35-24859 - Apr. 11)

(Rel. 34-26712); and (SR-Phlx-89-16) to prohibit a specialist from applying for new listings for up to one year following the removal of a security from the specialist in a reallocation or disciplinary proceeding. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 17.

INTERIM APPROVAL OF A STAY REQUEST

The Commission approved, on an interim basis, a request by the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) and the Chicago Board of Trade (CBT) to stay the April 11, 1989 Commission order approving proposed rule changes by the Philadelphia and American Stock Exchanges (SR-Phlx-88-7; SR-Amex-88-10) and the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-88-9) to list and trade index participations. The stay was granted pending completion of review of the CME/CBT Application and entry of the order thereon by the Commission. (Rel. 34-26728)
