ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST GORDON E. HARRY

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gordon E. Harry, a registered representative formerly associated with Covey & Company. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Harry's Offer of Settlement in which he admitted the Commission's finding that he was permanently enjoined, by consent, from violating the registration, antifraud, and anti manipulation provisions of the securities laws in SEC v. DataForce International, Inc., et al, Civ. Action No. 86-5564, NDCA (LR-11242). Harry also consented to the Commission's Order barring him from association with any broker or dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer, provided, however, that he may apply for association after two years from the date of the Order. PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST THE DAVID-MAXWELL COMPANY, INC. AND HOWARD M. CAPLAN

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against The David-Maxwell Company, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, and its president, Howard M. Caplan, and simultaneously accepted their Offer of Settlement and imposed sanctions. David-Maxwell, which has ceased its operations, formerly maintained its office in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

The Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions found that between September 11 and October 12, 1987, Respondents violated the anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act by charging excessive and undisclosed mark-ups in 231 transactions involving the sale of a common stock. The mark-ups ranged from 31% to 46.8%.

In accordance with the Offer, the Commission ordered that (1) David-Maxwell be censured and comply with its undertaking in the Offer to withdraw its registration as a broker-dealer, and (2) Caplan be suspended for one year from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

IRA MICHAEL PATTON ENJOINED IN DUCK BOOK LITIGATION

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on April 28 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered against Ira Michael Patton, who neither admitted nor denied the violations of the registration and antifraud provisions alleged in the Complaint. The Complaint alleged that Patton, Robert White, and Duck Book Communications, Ltd. had used Duck Book investment conferences, newsletters, and the magazine Duck Book to promote the sale to U.S. investors of Duck Book common stock on the Vancouver Stock Exchange at a time when they were misrepresenting and omitting to disclose material facts concerning the true financial condition and prospects of Duck Book and while Patton and White were selling their own unregistered stock into the public market at prices inflated by their promotional efforts. Patton was and continues to be an officer, director, and major shareholder of Duck Book Communications, which has remained ineligible for public trading on the Vancouver Stock Exchange since late 1985. Permanent injunctions were previously entered against codefendants White and Duck Book Communications during 1987 and 1988, respectively. (SEC v. Robert J. White, et al., USDC EDWA, Civil Action No. C-86-812-JLQ). (LR-12098)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Freedom Investment Trust for an order amending an existing Commission order to exempt certain current and future series of Applicant from the provisions of Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act. The requested order would permit an additional waiver of the CDSL imposed on certain redemptions by Unitholders of Freedom Income Trust or any future series of Freedom Income Trust whose shares were purchased in connection with the Dividend Reinvestment Program. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued clarifying the order dated May 12 [Rel. 35-24889] authorizing Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec), subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue and sell from time to time through December 31, 1989, up to an aggregate principal amount of \$100 million of first mortgage bonds and/or medium-term securities (MTNs) either as first mortgage bonds or unsecured notes in any combination thereof. Pursuant to Penelec's Mortgage and Deed of Trust, the MTNs will be subject to redemption or retirement prior to maturity upon the occurrence of certain events. (Rel. 35-24892 - May 17)

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of GUARDSMAN PRODUCTS, INC. to withdraw its common stock, \$1.00 par value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-26827)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-10) that would create new Section 45 to Article III of its Rules of Fair Practice. The proposed rule change would provide guidance for member firms concerning the handling of customer limit orders by a firm that is conducting both market making and retail activities. (Rel. 34-26824); and The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-89-3) that would amend Rule G-35, the Arbitration Code. The proposed rule change would require a dealer, within 20 days after receipt of an arbitration award against it, either to pay the award or deposit the award amount in an escrow account or provide the prevailing party with an irrevocable standby letter of credit. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 15.
