AMENDMENTS TO EMPLOYEE BENEFIT PLAN REGISTRATION AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS PROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission is proposing for comment rule and form changes to the registration and reporting requirements relating to employee benefit plans, including (1) amendment of Form S-8 to streamline registration procedures under the Securities Act of 1933; (2) amendment to Form 11-K under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to eliminate the requirement for the annual description of the plan's operations; and (3) related new rules and rule amendments.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION DISMISSED; JUDGMENT AWARDING ATTORNEYS' FEES TO BLINDER, ROBINSON & CO., INC. AMENDED

The Denver Regional Office announced that on May 30 U.S. District Judge Lewis T. Babcock, District of Colorado, amended his April 11 Judgment which (1) dismissed the Commission's 1983 injunctive case alleging violations of the customer protection requirements of Rule 15c3-3 against Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc., Meyer Blinder, and Larry Blinder; (2) precluded the Commission from using testimony or documents obtained in that injunctive case in any administrative or adjudicative proceeding against the defendants; and (3) awarded Blinder, Robinson their attorneys' fees and costs. The May 30 order granted, in part, and denied, in part, the Commission's Rule 59(e) Motion to Amend Judgment. The Court held that Rule 37(b) limits the award of reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, to those caused by the failure to provide discovery. Accordingly, the attorneys' fees and costs in this case are to be awarded to defendants from the date when the Court first directed the Commission's witness to comply with a discovery request to the present. (SEC v. Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc., et al., USDC CO, Civil Action No. 83-B-668). (LR-12124)
