COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSIONER SCHAPIRO CONFIRMED

Mary L. Schapiro was confirmed by the Senate to a five-year term as a Commissioner in a voice vote on Saturday, November 18, 1989. Commissioner Schapiro's confirmation hearing was held on Thursday, November 16; her nomination was voted on affirmatively by the Senate Banking Committee that day. She assumes a term expiring in 1994.

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT FILED

Daniel L. Goelzer, General Counsel of the Commission, announced that the Commission filed with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in San Francisco a friend-of-the-court brief in Hollinger v. Titan Capital Corp. The brief, filed at the request of the court, argues that the court should hear en banc three questions relating to the liability of a broker-dealer for wrongs committed by one of its salesmen. The brief states that (1) defendants should bear the burden of proving "good faith" as a defense to "controlling person" liability under Section 20(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; (2) the doctrine of respondeat superior may be used to establish liability in damage actions under the securities laws; and (3) the common law definition of recklessness -- a conscious indifference to the truth, falsity or misleading nature of a misrepresentation -- should be used in determining whether the scienter requirement of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 has been satisfied. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DECISION DISQUALIFYING WILLIAM A. CALVO, III FROM APPEARING OR PRACTICING BEFORE THE COMMISSION FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge disqualifying William A. Calvo, III, of Hendersonville, North Carolina, from appearing or practicing before the Commission until July 28, 1990 has become final. Calvo is an attorney admitted to practice in Florida and New York. According to the law judge's decision, Calvo was enjoined in 1988 by the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws based upon the court's findings that Calvo had violated or aided and abetted violations of those provisions in connection with a public offering of the stock of Electronics Warehouse, Inc. The law judge disqualified Calvo for two years, but gave him credit for the period of time since he was initially suspended from practice before the Commission. (Rel. 34-27437)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INSIDER TRADING CASE FILED, COURT GRANTS TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On November 16, the Commission filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Finacor Anstalt and CERTAIN PURCHASERS OF CALL OPTION CONTRACTS FOR THE COMMON STOCK OF COMBUSTION ENGINEERING, INC. alleging that defendants violated basic antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with their purchases of common stock and call option contracts for the common stock of Combustion Engineering shortly before the November 13 public announcement of a tender offer for the common stock of Combustion Engineering. The Complaint alleges that Finacor made illegal profits of approximately \$2.8 million and that the other defendant purchasers, who traded through foreign financial institutions and whose names are not presently known, made illegal profits of approximately \$382,000. Judge

Milton Pollack entered an order which, among other things, temporarily restrains defendants from future violations and freezes their assets. The Complaint also seeks permanent injunctive relief and penalties in the amount of up to three times any illegal trading profits. A hearing is scheduled for December 1 to consider the Commission's application for preliminary injunctive relief. (SEC v. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
