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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT NAMES ROBERT CHARLES TROUP, HELMUT AUGUST ALPERS

The Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut seeking permanent injunctive and other equitable relief against Robert Charles Troup and Helmut August Alpers. The Complaint alleges that Troup violated Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 in purchases of the common stock of Gartner Group, Inc. and that Alpers aided and abetted Troup's violations of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 and violated Section 14(e) and Rule 14e-3. The complaint alleges that Alpers advised Troup of material, nonpublic information regarding Saatchi & Saatchi Company, PLC's interest in acquiring Gartner Group, which Alpers learned as a result of his employment with Gartner Group. Troup subsequently traded in Gartner Group common stock.

Alpers, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to the entry of a proposed permanent injunction, enjoining him from violations of, and from aiding and abetting violations of, Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 and ordering him to pay a penalty of \$78,812.50 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. ### INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST WILLIAM FLYNN AND FULL DISGORGEMENT PAID BY OTHER DEFENDANTS

The Denver Regional Office announced that, on December 13, U.S. District Judge Jim R. Carrigan, District of Colorado, permanently enjoined William Flynn, a Denver-based registered representative of a "penny stock" brokerage firm, from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Flynn consented to the order without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations.

The two other defendants in the action, Jonas E. Curtiss and Norma Jeanne Productions, Inc. (NJP), were similarly enjoined on December 29, 1988 and ordered to disgorge \$30,000 which, under the terms of the order, will be distributed to fully reimburse investors in NJP. Within the last month, after the court scheduled a contempt hearing at the Commission's request, Flynn and NJP made full payment, with interest, to the Registry of the Court. The four investors who were allegedly defrauded by the defendants, for amounts up to \$10,000, will soon be reimbursed by the Court for the full amounts of their investments plus interest. (SEC v. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### ALLIED CAPITAL CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting Allied Capital Corporation, et al. from Section 17(a) of the Act, approving certain joint transactions, and permitting the externalization of the presently internalized management functions. (Rel. IC-17269 - Dec. 19)

### PUBLIC FACILITY LOAN TRUST

An order has been issued on an application of Shawmut Bank, N.A., not in its individual capacity, but solely as trustee on behalf of the Public Facility Loan Trust (the Trust), amending the order issued in Investment Company Act Release No. 16502 (July 28, 1988). The previous order granted the Trust relief from Sections 10(h), 14(a), 16(a), 17(a) and (d), 18(a), (c), and (i), and 32(a) of the Act in connection with the issuance of bonds and two classes of certificates of beneficial interest in the Trust collateralized by certain loans originated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The amended order grants an exemption from the requirement of Rule 8b-16 promulgated under Section 8(b) of the Act that the Trust file an annual amendment to its Registration Statement on Form N-2. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company (Georgia), an electric public-utility subsidiary of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to an aggregate of \$250 million principal amount of variable rate first mortgage bonds to be issued and sold from time to time, on or prior to December 31, 1989. Jurisdiction has been reserved over other matters proposed in the amended application-declaration pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-25006)

### CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through December 31, 1994 its common stock (\$2.75 par) and excepting Consolidated from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Rule 50(a)(5) in connection with its issuance of common stock, as follows: Up to 1,500,000 shares in connection with its dividend reinvestment plan (Rel. 35-25002); and up to 210,348 shares in connection with its dividend reinvestment plan and up to 154,268 shares in connection with its employee stock ownership plan. (Rel. 35-25003)

### CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Central Power and Light Company (CP&L), wholly owned electric public-utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through December 31,

1990, up to \$170 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds and/or debentures (New Securities).

CP&L further proposes that the proceeds from the sale of the New Securities be used for the acquisition, by a cash tender offer, through December 31, 1990, of all or a portion of CP&L's First Mortgage Bonds, Series V, 11-5/8%, due August 1, 2015, and CP&L's 12% debentures, Series 1985, due September 1, 2015. (Rel. 35-25004)

#### WEST TEXAS UTILITIES COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing West Texas Utilities Company (WTU), wholly owned electric public-utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through December 31, 1990, up to \$75 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds (New Bonds).

WTU further proposes that the proceeds from the sale of New Bonds be used for the acquisition, by a cash tender offer, through December 31, 1990, of all or a portion of WTU's First Mortgage Bonds, Series M, 11-3/4%, due August 1, 2015. (Rel. 35-25005)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
