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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### LEE SHROUT, OTHERS PLEAD GUILTY

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Central District of California announced that on July 11 Ralph Ernstsen pleaded guilty to one count of securities fraud and E. Michael Furlong pleaded guilty to one count each of securities and mail fraud. In addition, on July 28, Lee ShROUT, of Newport Beach, California, pleaded guilty to three counts of violations of the securities and mail fraud statutes.

According to the indictment, which is the result of a joint investigation by the Commission and the U.S. Attorney's Office, from October 1983 to January 1984 the defendants manipulated the over-the-counter market for the common stock of ABEX, Ltd. from \$.10 to over \$5 a share. According to the indictment and the guilty pleas, ShROUT, president of Certificate Transfer Company, a stock transfer agency in Newport Beach, disseminated false and misleading information to the public regarding ABEX. Moreover, Furlong, a stockbroker at Union Securities in Pasadena, and Ernstsen, an investor, generated fictitious trading activity for ABEX common stock by placing matched orders for the stock and purchasing shares without making payment.

The defendants are scheduled to appear before Judge Manuel E. Real on September 8 for sentencing. (U.S. Lee ShROUT, et al., USDC CA, Cr. 85-628). (LR-11173)

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Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
