CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST GOLDEN BEAR RESOURCES, LTD., OTHERS

The Seattle Regional Office filed a complaint for injunction and other equitable relief on September 5 in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington against Golden Bear Resources, Ltd., a Canadian corporation trading its stock on the Vancouver Stock Exchange; Kazimir Golac, director; and Leonard Zrnic and Jana Whyman, promoters of Golden Bear, all of Vancouver, B.C.; G.C. George Securities, Inc., a Washington corporation and broker-dealer; Gene George, president; and Sharon Hautzinger and Gordon Sargent, salespersons of G.C. George, all of Spokane, Washington.

The complaint alleges that the defendants were involved in the sale of unregistered Golden Bear common stock, employment of manipulative and deceptive devices in connection with the sales of that stock, records and reporting violations surrounding the sales, and unlawful credit extension to customers, among other things. (SEC v. Golden Bear Resources, Ltd., et al., USDC EDWA, File No. C-86-736-JLQ). (LR-11228)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST NATIONAL BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on September 11 U.S. District Judge Norman C. Roettger, Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against National Business Communications Corporation, a Florida corporation located in Pompano Beach, Florida. National, without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint, consented to the Final Judgment. The Final Judgment enjoins National from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and the books and records, accounting controls, proxy solicitation, and reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act.

The complaint alleges that National, in connection with its initial public offering and thereafter, issued a registration statement, an annual report on Form 10-K, periodic reports on Forms 10-Q, and certain proxy materials, which contained false and misleading financial statements and other misrepresentations and omissions of material facts, and which concealed National's deteriorating financial condition. The financial statements were alleged to be misleading in that, among other things, they included inventory valuations which failed to account for obsolescence, failed to disclose certain compensation paid to National's officers, included receivables which were known to be uncollectable and reflected anticipated tax benefits to which National could not reasonably become entitled. (SEC v. National Business Communications Corporation, et al., Civil Action No. 86-6535-CIV-ROETTGER, SDPL). (LR-11229)
