ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD J. BOREN SUSPENDED

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers and Securities Exchange Acts against Richard J. Boren of Los Angeles, California. Boren consented to the Commission's Order Making Findings that the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California entered an Order, by consent, permanently enjoining Boren from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and Exchange Act in his offer and sale of unregistered securities of the Janus Financial Group, Inc.

Under the Remedial Sanctions imposed by the Commission's Order, Boren was suspended from employment, affiliation or association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser or investment company for 45 days. For 12 months following the issuance of the Order, Boren is subject to supervision by a person with appropriate qualifications and is limited to recommending only securities transactions recommended by his employing, affiliated or associated firm.

The sanctions were imposed under Boren's Offer of Settlement, submitted simultaneously with the institution of the Order for Proceedings and without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein, except for those relating to the U.S. District Court's Injunction. (Rel. IA-949)
