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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Chairman Shad will testify on April 24 before the Senate Appropriations Hearing. The hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. in Room S-146, U.S. Capitol.

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### STOP ORDER ENTERED AGAINST DIVERSIFIED TECH, INC.

The Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding against Diversified Tech, Inc., a Utah corporation. In anticipation of the proceeding, Diversified submitted an Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's Order, it consented to the Commission's Findings and Order.

In the stop order proceeding under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933, the Commission found that a registration statement filed by Diversified was misleading and omitted material information required by Regulation S-K concerning Diversified's sole product, an orthopedic pin. The Commission suspended the effectiveness of the registration statement. (Rel. 33-6576)

### DIVERSIFIED TECH, INC. ORDERED TO AMEND FORM 10

The Commission instituted a public administrative proceeding against Diversified Tech, Inc., a Utah corporation. In anticipation of the proceeding, Diversified submitted an Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's Order, it consented to the Commission's Findings and Order.

The proceeding, under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, concerned a Form 10 filed under Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act. The Commission found that Diversified violated Section 12(g) because its financial statements in Form 10 materially overstated its assets and are not presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. The overvaluation was due to Diversified's failure to value assets in accordance with the predecessor cost requirements of Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 48 and its failure to expense certain research and development costs in accordance with Statement of Financial Accounting Standard No. 2, paragraph 12. The Commission ordered Diversified to amend its filing to correct these deficiencies within 60 days and to mail a copy of the Commission Order to its shareholders. (Rel. 34-21961; AAE-55)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### BANK OF NEW ZEALAND

An order has been issued on an application by the Bank of New Zealand, a commercial bank organized under the laws of New Zealand, and its subsidiary, BNZ North America Inc., a Delaware corporation, for an exemption from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit Applicants to issue and sell commercial paper in the United States. ## THE UNION CENTRAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Union Central Life Insurance Company, Carillon Account and Carillon Investments, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act in the issuance of certain flexible premium individual deferred variable annuity contracts. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### PROCTER & GAMBLE COMPANY

An order has been issued on the application by the Procter & Gamble Company under Section 310(b)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 declaring that the trusteeship of Bankers Trust Company of four indentures of or related to Procter & Gamble, two of which are qualified under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Bankers Trust from acting as trustee under more than one of such indentures. 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### SEARS MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORPORATION

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
