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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### DATE SET FOR SUSPENSION OF HARBINE FINANCIAL SERVICE AND JESSE ROSENBLUM

In May 1984, the Commission suspended the investment adviser registration of Jesse Rosenblum, doing business as Harbine Financial Service, of Closter, New Jersey for six months. It also suspended Rosenblum from association with any investment adviser for the same period. The Commission found that Rosenblum's advertising brochures were fraudulent in that they did not disclose a 1980 injunction entered against Rosenblum, downplayed the risks of having Rosenblum manage clients' funds, and made it appear that Harbine was more than it really was -- a part-time operation. The Commission also found that Rosenblum failed to amend his registration application to report the injunction, and failed to amend his application promptly to disclose the entry of a New Jersey cease and desist order.

Rosenblum's suspensions were stayed pending appeal. The Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit recently affirmed the Commission's order. Accordingly, the Commission made the suspensions effective May 28. (Rel. IA-971)

### A-D LIMITED, OTHERS SANCTIONED

The Commission, under delegated authority, entered Findings and Order by Default in an administrative proceeding under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 revoking the broker-dealer registration of A-D Limited and Trinity Corporation International, and permanently barring William P. Coon from association with any broker-dealer.

The Commission's Order found, based on the February 12, 1985 Order for Proceedings, that Coon wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5, and that Coon was convicted of mail and securities fraud on April 21, 1983. In view of the failure of A-D, Trinity and Coon to answer the Order for Proceedings or file a Notice of Appearance, they were found in default and the allegations in the Order for Proceedings were deemed to be true in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT NAMES MARYANN SARZYNSKI, OTHERS

The Commission filed a complaint on May 22 against MaryAnn Sarzynski, Charles Sarzynski, Ralph Anderson, James Crocicchia, Gary Frost, Donald Grady, Paul Smith and Anthony Dicerto, all residing in southern Connecticut, alleging violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The complaint alleges that, from about late 1982 through 1983, the defendants, directly and indirectly, effected transactions in the common stock and options contracts for the common stock of certain publicly-held companies while in possession of material nonpublic information concerning the forthcoming recommendation to purchase the securities of those publicly-held companies in publications of Value Line, Inc., an investment adviser registered with the Commission, resulting in aggregate net profits of \$157,243.75.

The defendants, without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, consented to Final Judgments restraining and enjoining them from violating the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 and ordering them to disgorge their profits. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### SUN LIFE ASSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY OF NEW YORK

An order has been issued exempting Sun Life Insurance and Annuity Company of New York, Sun Life (N.Y.) Variable Accounts A and B (the Accounts) and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. (together, Applicants), from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act, permitting the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the Accounts in the sale of certain variable annuity contracts. ### EASTWEST PENNY STOCK FUND, INC.; AMERICAN CAPITAL OPTION INCOME FUND, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until June 14 to request a hearing on an application by Eastwest Penny Stock Fund, Inc. and American Capital Option Income Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-14530; IC-14531 - May 21)

### COLLATERALIZED MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting Collateralized Mortgage Securities Corporation from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14533 - May 21)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 14 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, to form a new subsidiary, CSW Credit, Inc. (Credit), which will have the initial purpose of purchasing the accounts receivable of CSW's operating companies. It is also proposed that Credit be permitted to have an average capital structure approximating a debt-equity ratio of 80% and 20%, respectively, and that CSW be permitted to borrow under lines of credit or loan agreements an aggregate amount of up to \$320 million and provide additional capital through equity contributions in an amount up to \$80 million, through December 31, 1986. ### MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued regarding the issuance and sale of first mortgage bonds by Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Middle South Energy, Inc. (MSE), Arkansas Power and Light Company, Mississippi Power and Light Company, Louisiana Power and Light Company, and New Orleans Public Service Inc. MSE will issue and sell not more than \$100 million in principal amount of its first mortgage bonds in one series not later than October 31, 1985. This supplemental order releases jurisdiction over the negotiated terms of the financing and related fees, commissions and expenses. (Rel. 35-23700 - May 21)

### CONESVILLE COAL PREPARATION COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing five subsidiaries of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to lease additional coal mining equipment with an aggregate acquisition cost not exceeding \$20 million and certain other equipment from a nonaffiliate company. The subsidiaries are: Conesville Coal Preparation Company, Central Ohio Coal Company, Southern Ohio Coal Company, Windsor Power House Coal Company and Simco, Inc. (Rel. 35-23701 - May 22)

### INDIANA & MICHIGAN ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Indiana & Michigan Electric Company, subsidiary of American Power Company, Inc., to sell certain electrical distribution facilities in place to the City of Mishawaka, Indiana. (Rel. 35-23702 - May 22)

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES
