ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

GEORGE E. LAWSON CITED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against George E. Lawson of Danbury, Connecticut, formerly registered as a sole proprietor broker-dealer.

Simultaneously with the institution of proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Lawson. Lawson consented to a Commission Order containing findings that he pled guilty to two counts of an information [U.S. v. George E. Lawson, No. 83 Crim. 164 (MEL), S.D.N.Y., March 24, 1983] which: (1) involved the sale of a security; (2) arose out of the conduct of the business of a bank; and (3) involved the counterfeiting of securities and the fraudulent conversion of funds.

Lawson further consented to a Commission Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-20579)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

OIL & GAS PROMOTERS ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on January 24 Judge William Taylor, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, entered Orders of Permanent Injunction enjoining Golden Petroleum Corporation and William C. Brown, both of Bethesda, Maryland, from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Golden and Brown consented to the Orders without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's September 29, 1983 complaint. Also named as a defendant in the complaint was Howard L. Strahan, Dallas, Texas, who agreed to an Order of Permanent Injunction as to the same violations on October 4, 1983.

The complaint alleged that: from about July 1980 through March 1982, in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act, Golden, Brown and Strahan offered and sold interests in 16 Texas limited partnerships formed to engage in oil and gas exploration, raising approximately \$6 million from 200 investors in 17 states and the District of Columbia; and, in the sales of the interests, the defendants made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning the extent of oil and gas production from wells drilled by the limited partnerships, the cost of oil and gas leases, the use and escrowing of investor funds, Strahan's relationship with Golden, and the return a limited partner would receive on his investment. (SEC v. Golden Petroleum Corporation, et al., USDC/ND/TX/Dallas Div., CA 3-83-1669C). (LR-10276)
