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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### AIR FLORIDA SYSTEMS, AIR FLORIDA, INC.

The Commission, in this Chapter 11 reorganization case, filed a brief in an appeal to the district court on October 22 supporting the bankruptcy court's order approving the application of Air Florida Systems, Air Florida, Inc. (debtors) to sell substantially all of its property outside the context of a plan of reorganization. The Commission argued that the bankruptcy court's findings of adequate business justification were consistent with the standards enunciated by the Second Circuit in In re The Lionel Corporation, 722 F.2d 1063 (2d Cir. 1983), and support the proposed sale. The Commission also argued that the presence of interim financing and operating agreements, which permit the debtors and the purchaser to operate the airline as a joint venture pending closing of the sale, do not place the entire transaction beyond the scope of a permissible sale of assets. (Air Florida Systems; Air Florida, Inc., Nos. 84-01223, 04-01224, SD FL). (Rel. CR-335)

### DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO THE GENERAL COUNSEL TO FILE NOTICES OF APPEARANCE IN BANKRUPTCY REORGANIZATION CASES

The Commission amended its regulations governing delegation of authority to delegate to the General Counsel the authority to file notices of appearance in bankruptcy reorganization cases under Section 1109(a) of the Bankruptcy Code involving debtors, the securities of which are registered or required to be registered under Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### OSWALD SERRANO SUSPENDED

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Oswald Serrano in public administrative proceedings previously instituted under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. In his Offer, Serrano, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Order for Proceedings, consented to findings that he wilfully aided and abetted violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws which involved the misappropriation and conversion of customer funds, totalling approximately \$750,000, by the former branch manager of a registered broker-dealer. Serrano, who was associated with the registered broker-dealer as a branch operations manager, aided and abetted the former branch manager by: failing to follow established firm procedures in regard to the disbursement of firm checks payable to customers; negotiating firm checks payable to customers to which the former branch manager had forged customer endorsements; and failing to report his hesitancy in continuing to negotiate the forged checks to anyone in the compliance department of the registered broker-dealer.

As a result of his Offer, Serrano was suspended from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities broker, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company for 15 business day. (Rel. 34-21393)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ALLAN G. COOPER CITED

The Houston Branch Office announced that on September 28 Judge Carl O. Bue, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Allan G. Cooper of Kingwood, Texas. The Order permanently

enjoined Cooper from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Cooper consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the September 19 complaint.

The complaint alleges that from June 1979 to about July 1983, Cooper raised approximately \$12,500,000 from approximately 200 investors through the offer and sale of 50 limited partnerships and investment promissory notes issued by Kingwood Financial Group, Inc. and through the investment advisory business of Tax Utilization Planning Corporation. The complaint also alleges that Cooper made material misrepresentations concerning the: use of investor proceeds; practice of redeeming promissory notes of past investors with funds raised from new investors through subsequent and unrelated offerings; potential profits which clients could expect from their investment; and financial condition of Tax Utilization and Kingwood Financial. The complaint further alleges that Cooper violated the registration provisions of the securities laws through the offer and sale of the unregistered promissory notes. (SEC v. Allan G. Cooper, USDC SD TX, Houston Division, Civil Action No. H-84-3817). (LR-10576)

#### COMPLAINT NAMES STOCK LOAN "FINDERS" FOR FRAUD

The New York Regional Office filed a complaint on October 16 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, against Paul Alampi, Encore Institutional Services, Ltd. and Dunn Institutional Service, Ltd. for violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The complaint charges that Alampi, through Encore and Dunn, stock loan "finder" firms which he controlled, fraudulently arranged stock loans between Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. and MKI Securities Corp. involving securities valued at approximately \$127 million. The defendants requested MKI to deliver securities to Merrill which Merrill had not sought to borrow. Alampi timed delivery of these stock loans so as to prevent the detection and same-day return of these securities by Merrill. As a result of their scheme, the defendants realized illegal profits of approximately \$50,000. (SEC v. Paul Alampi, et al., 84 Civ. 7397 [RWS] SDNY). (LR-10577)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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#### SAFECO TAX-FREE MONEY MARKET FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Safeco Tax-Free Money Market Fund, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(41) and 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act to permit it to acquire rights to sell its portfolio securities to broker-dealers and to value such rights in the manner proposed in the application. (Rel. IC-14211 - Oct. 24)

#### PENSION HEDGE FUND INC.

An order has been issued declaring that Pension Hedge Fund Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14212 - Oct. 24)

#### DREXEL BURNHAM LAMBERT INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Drexel Burnham Lambert Incorporated on behalf of all presently outstanding or subsequently issued series of High Income Trust Securities (Trusts) requesting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit Drexel to engage in certain principal transactions with the Trusts. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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#### MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal of Middle South Utilities, Inc. (Middle South), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Middle South Services, Inc., whereby Middle South will guarantee the performance of additional lease obligations by its subsidiary under a computer leasing agreement, without recourse to the subsidiary first being required. (Rel. 35-23461 - Oct. 24)

## CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central Power and Light Company, subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to finance up to \$139,200,000 of pollution control facilities and reserving jurisdiction over an additional \$60,800,000. (Rel. 35-23462 - Oct. 25)

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### UNION PACIFIC CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 22 to request a hearing on an application by the Union Pacific Corporation, under Section 310(b)(1) (ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939, declaring that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A. under certain specified indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Citibank from acting as trustee. 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## MISCELLANEOUS

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### PRESIDIO MANAGEMENT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19 to request a hearing on an application of Presidio Management requesting an order exempting its advisory fee arrangements with Geary Partners, L.P., a California limited partnership, from the prohibition of Section 205(1) of the Investment Advisers Act, and exempting Presidio from the recordkeeping requirements of Section 204 of the Act and Rules 204-2(b) and (c) to the extent such provisions require separate records be maintained for each limited partner.
