## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### BAYSWATER REALTY & CAPITAL CORP. ENJOINED, OTHER RELIEF GRANTED

The U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Order permanently restraining and enjoining Bayswater Realty & Capital Corp., of New York City, from violating Section 7(a) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The Final Order also required it to comply with undertakings to: complete its registration as an investment company under the Act; not to effect a reorganization or Rule 13e-3 transaction unless fair and equitable to all of its shareholders; deem the sellers in a September 1982 tender offer for its stock to be recordholders for purposes of any "going private" transaction it may effect within 30 months following the entry of the Final Order; and make a filing with the Commission concerning the Commission's action and provide copies of the filing to its present shareholders and former shareholders who sold stock in the September 1982 tender offer. Bayswater consented to the Court's Final Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleged that: from about April 30, 1981, Bayswater violated Section 7(a) of the Act by effecting transactions and engaging in business while an investment company, but not registered as such with Commission; and Bayswater was primarily engaged in the business of investing, reinvesting and trading in securities. From the end of its 1981 and 1982 fiscal years, Bayswater invested, reinvested, owned, held or traded in securities and owned investment securities having a value exceeding 40 percent of the value of its total assets (exclusive of government securities and cash items) on an unconsolidated basis.

Bayswater, while an investment company, engaged in transactions in which affiliates were joint and several participants without filing an application and obtaining an order from the Commission approving such transactions. Also, Bayswater's Chairman purchased Bayswater securities in negotiated transactions, and Icahn Acquisition Corp., an entity controlled by Bayswater's Chairman, conducted the September 1982 tender offer for Bayswater stock. ### ACCELERATED, PARTIAL AND TEMPORARY APPROVAL

The Commission has approved, on a partial and temporary accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-83-14). The rule change amends PSE Rule II, Section 8(c) to provide that a PSE specialist may execute odd-lot orders by mutual agreement with the PSE member at the existing round-lot bid or offering price. Accelerated approval applies only to Rule II, Section 8(c). The proposed rule change would also amend Rule III, Section 12 which sets forth the operation and basic characteristics of SCOREX. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
