### CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Central Power and Light Company, subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to complete a negotiated private placement of up to 500,000 shares of preferred stock. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: The Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-83-19) which would effect changes in MSTC'S bylaws to conform with the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Division of Market Regulation's standards for full registration of clearing agencies. The changes would: (a) define the powers of the Board of Directors; (b) eliminate the classes of directors and expand the Board from 13 to 17 directors; (c) establish a nominating committee to select candidates with a view towards providing fair representation of a cross-section of MSTC's participants; and (d) set forth the composition and responsibilities of the compensation, finance and nominating committees. (Rel. 34-20452); The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-83-20) to add non-member broker-dealers' proprietary orders to the current prohibition against the placing of members' proprietary orders with the PSE's options Order Book Officials. (Rel. 34-20453); and (SR-PSE-83-21) to permit the use of hand signals on the options floor of the PSE in certain limited circumstances. (Rel. 34-20457)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the weeks of November 28, December 12, and December 5.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
