Web2.0 Tool #1:

Poll Everywhere

Live Audience Polling

Poll Everywhere is a simple text message or web-based voting application that is

designed for use with live audiences. People vote by sending text messages or web votes to options displayed onscreen. The poll will update in real time

Here is how simple it is:

- 1. Ask a your class a question
- 2. Students use the web link to answer the question
- 3. Results update live
- 4. Multiple Choice & free response


Why use Poll Everywhere?

- Increase classroom participation and attentiveness
- Encourage risk-taking with anonymous student responses
- Elicit diverse opinions when there isn't a correct answer
- Expose social misconceptions
- Gauge student comprehension of material immediately
- Grab students with thought-provoking opening questions
- Allow students to provide instructor feedback
- Automate taking attendance
- Assess last night's reading with a quick quiz
- Strengthen retention

It's a dictionary and a thesaurus.

It's color-coded to show parts of speech, opposites, synonyms, etc.
