1. What can I do with SlideBoom?

You can convert any content created in PowerPoint into Flash and share it with your friends, family, colleagues, clients, teachers, students, and the whole world. You can share the following types of multimedia content that you create:

- Slideshows (photos, text, shapes, audio, etc.)
- E-cards
- E-learning content (lectures and tutorials)
- Business content (presentations and demo slideshows)
- Virtual tours of homes, museums, special events, and more

2. What formats are supported by SlideBoom?

SlideBoom supports PowerPoint 2000, XP, 2003 and 2007 presentations (*.ppt, *.pptx) and slideshows (*.pps, *.ppsx). The largest file size allowed is 100 megs.

What is MagMyPic?

MagMyPic.com is a website that allows you to upload any photo and put it on the cover of a unique magazine. Users can then publish their magazine to their own social networking profile, website, blog, or anywhere they'd like.

They can also download the file in a variety of sizes to their computer. MagMyPic.com also offers <u>prints</u> of the unique magazine covers in a variet of sizes.

How do I make my own magazine cover?

Creating your own magazine company is actually quite easy. The first thing you need to do is visit our upload page, and upload a photo from your computer. Currently MagMyPic.com supports images that are JPG, JPEG, PNG, and GIF. Once you've uploaded your image, you'll then be able to crop and position the image while selecting from our wide array of magazine covers. Instantly your image will be transformed into a magazine cover. You'll then get the opportunity to name your file, and then publish/download/buy prints of your image.

What image types do you accept?

MagMyPic.com supports image <u>uploads</u> that are JPG, JPEG, PNG, and GIF. We hope to add support for BMP and other file types in the future.
