VoiceThread

A VoiceThread is a collaborative, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents and videos and allows people to leave comments in

5 ways- using voice (with a mic or phone), text, audio file, or video (via a webcam).

Share a VoiceThread with friends, students, and colleagues for them to record comments too.

Users can doodle while commenting, use multiple identities and pick which comments are shown through moderation. VoiceThreads can even be embedded on web sites and exported to MP3 players or DVDs as archival movies.

With VoiceThread, group conversations are collected and shared in one place from anywhere in the world. All with no software to install.

KIDO'Z

The KIDO'Z browser is a protected environment made for young kids that

enables children to surf sites, watch videos and play games
