## **Wounded Warrior Career Fair Scheduled**

WASHINGTON – Naval Sea Systems Command's Wounded Warrior hiring office will hold its first career fair for service-disabled veterans, July 26, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at its headquarters located at the Washington Navy Yard, Washington D.C.

Hiring managers from all government and civilian organizations are highly encouraged to attend and meet service-disabled veterans, whose unique skills, training, and leadership experience make them an asset to the American workforce. All veterans are welcome to attend. Hiring managers will be particularly interested in veterans with experience in program management, engineering, equipment maintenance, security, logistics, and administration.

Representatives from NAVSEA headquarters and several area commands such as Naval Facilities Command, Commander, Naval Installations Command, Naval Facilities Command, and Naval Air Systems Command will attend.
