## Summary Report of Occurrences Reviewed From May 25 – 29, 2009

## Significant Occurrences (1)

## Environmental Release/Compliance – 1 occurrence at 1 site

<u>NA – Los Alamos National Laboratory (Significance Category 3).</u> On May 22, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued a Notice of Violation to the Department of Energy and Los Alamos National Security, LLC, because of a failure to respond to the requirements set forth in the "Work Plan to Plug and Abandon Mortandad Canyon Wells Test Well 8 and WCOBT-4.4". NMED alleges the lab failed to abandon the groundwater monitoring well in a timely manner, which violates a 2005 cleanup order. Contamination is leaking from the well and is allegedly flowing in the direction of the drinking water aquifer at the lab. The proposed civil penalty is \$1,871,100.
